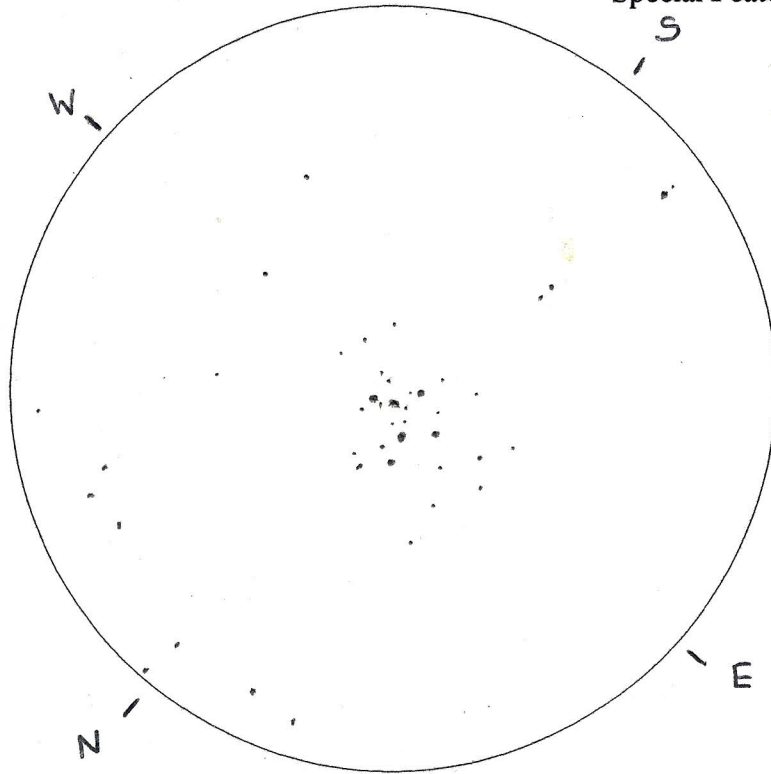

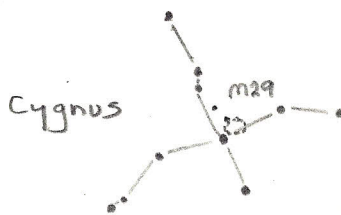

Description and Field Notes: A very sparse but bright open cluster consisting of seven or eight bright stars with twelve to fifteen dim stars interspersed. It is surrounded on all sides by fairly bright field stars, compact, with no visible nebulosity.
