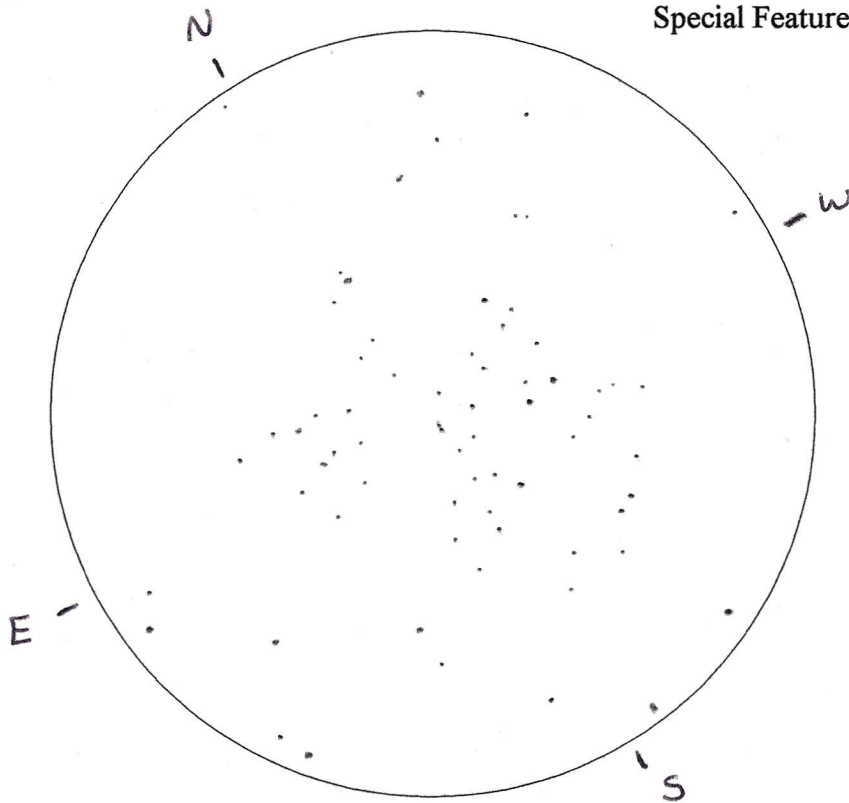

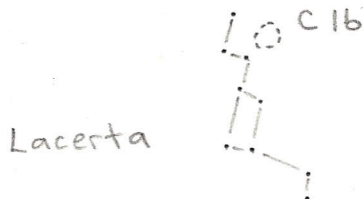

Description and Field Notes: Large cluster, fairly rich. A wide range of magnitudes from bright to dim. Almost seems divided into two clusters by a dark lane or void running NW to SE. A double star of magnitude 9 and a separation of about 5 arcseconds is at the center of the cluster, (Z2890)
