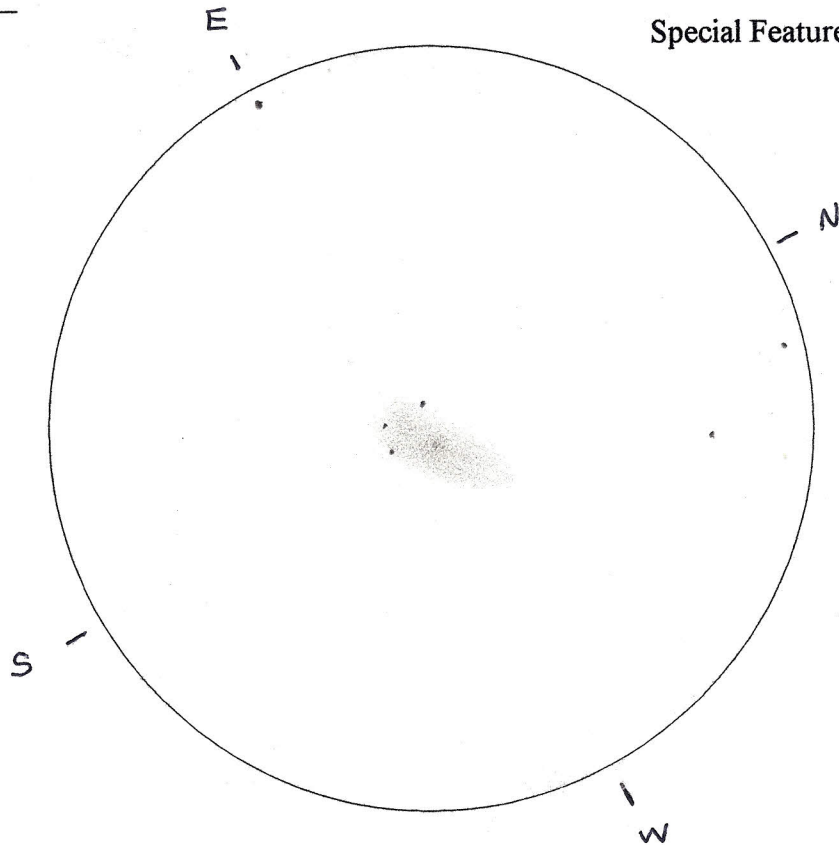

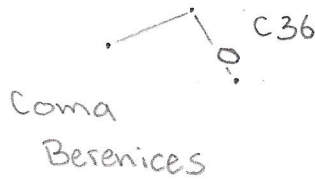


Viewed about halfway between edge-on and face-on.

Description and Field Notes: Low surface brightness, made worse by poor transparency. Elongated to an oval shape in the NW/SE direction. Diffuse cloud with somewhat brighter central core. Three stars surrounding the SE end.
