

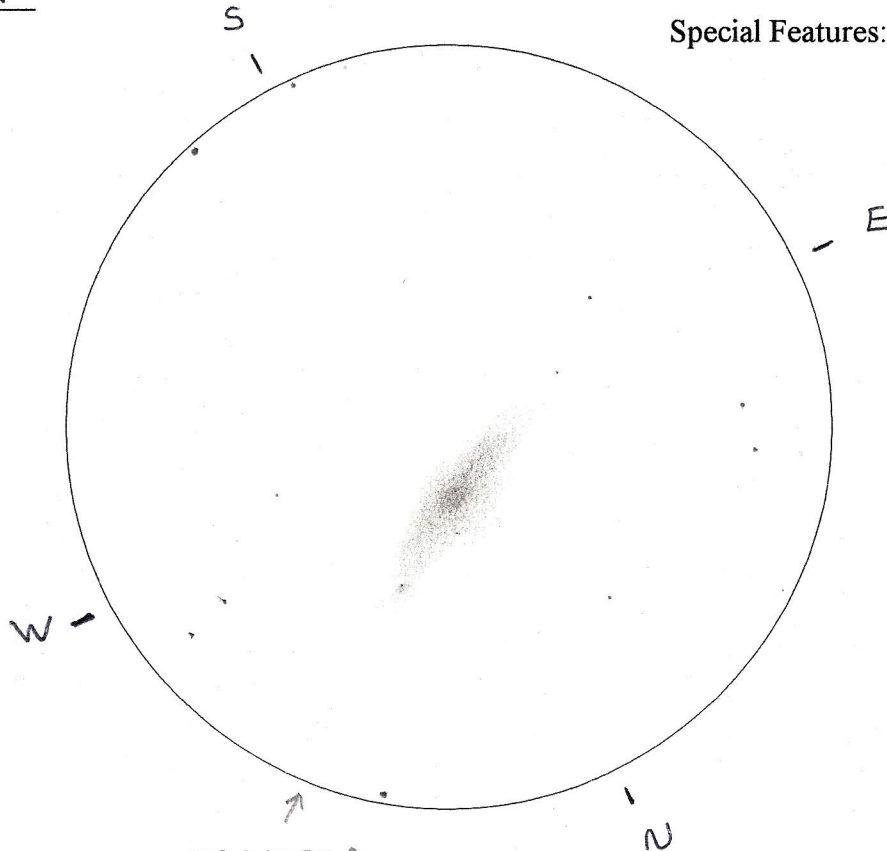

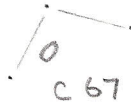

Fairly large but dim. Elongated NW/SE. Becoming brighter toward the center. Core round and brighter but not quite starlike. The SE end of the bar seems slightly brighter. No sign of the arms. The companion galaxy is visible as a hazy dim "star" just to the SW of the bar, (NGC 1097 A).
