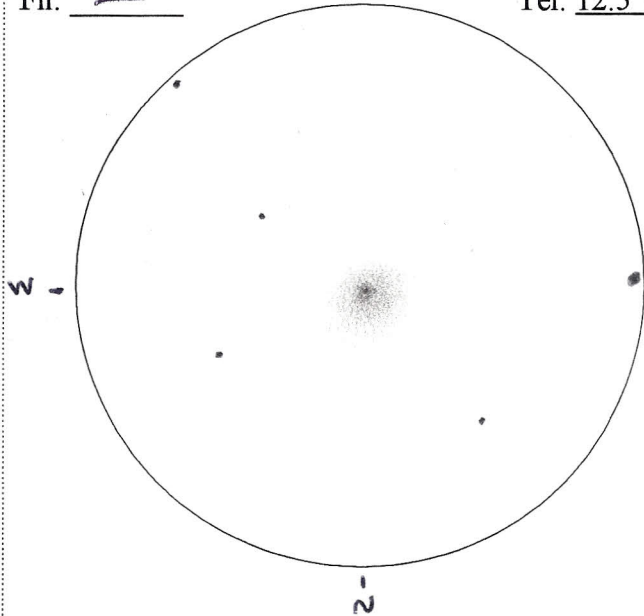
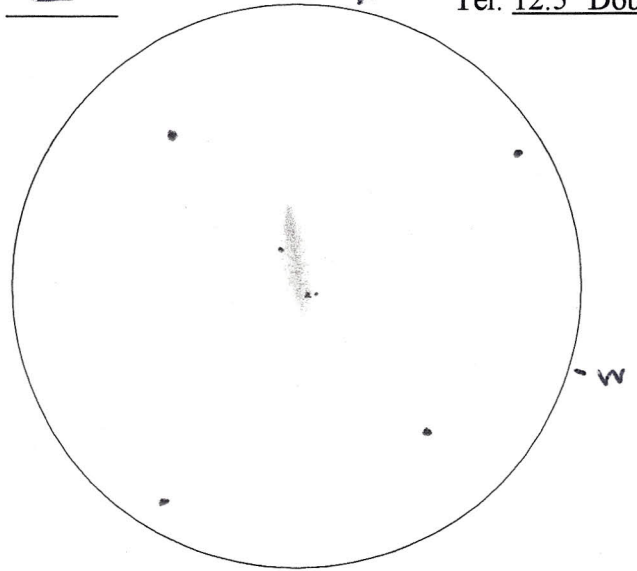

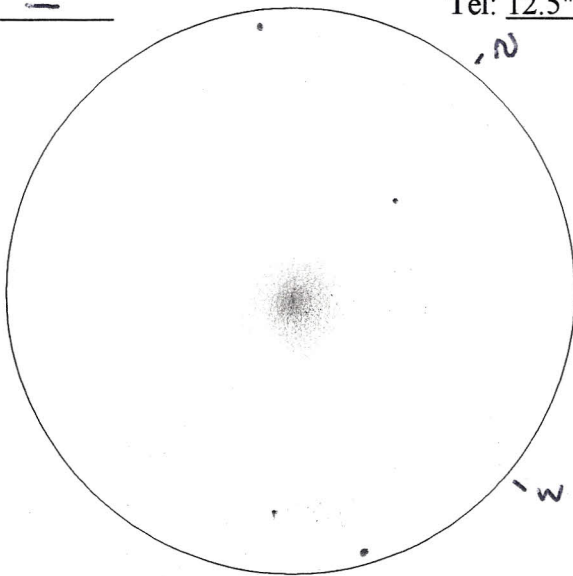
Circular, with diffuse halo with bright, concentrated core and faint starlike nucleus.

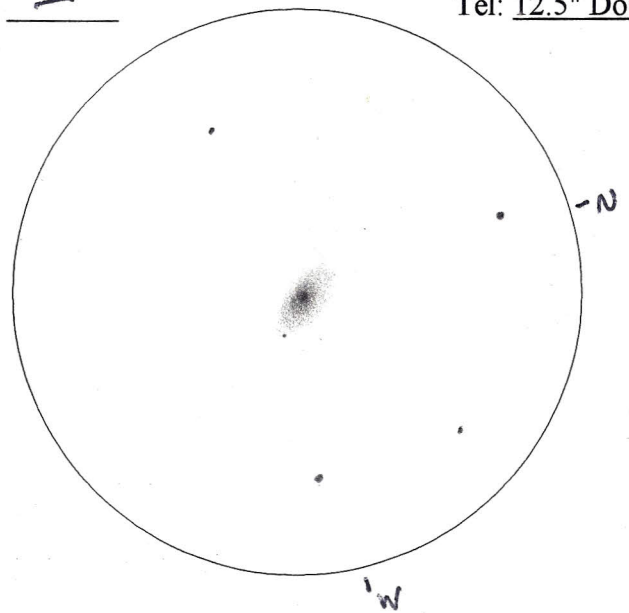
