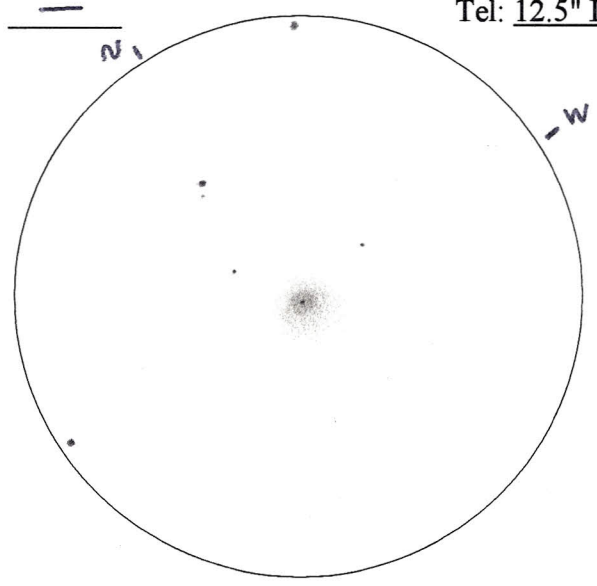


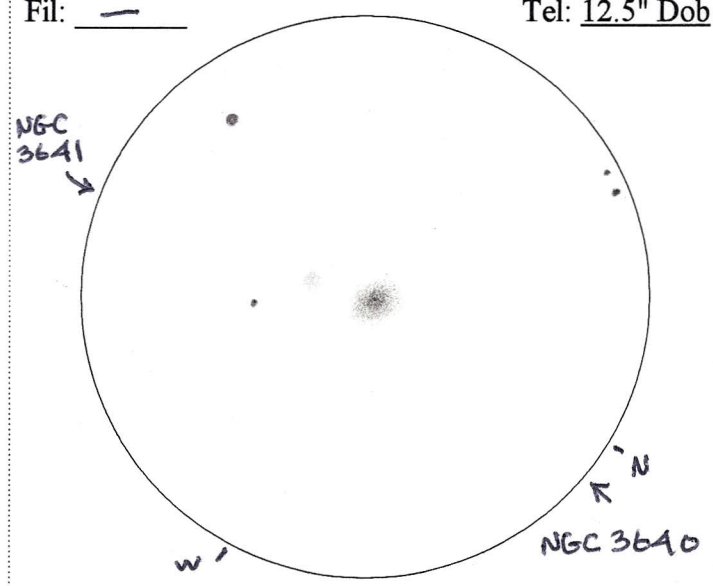

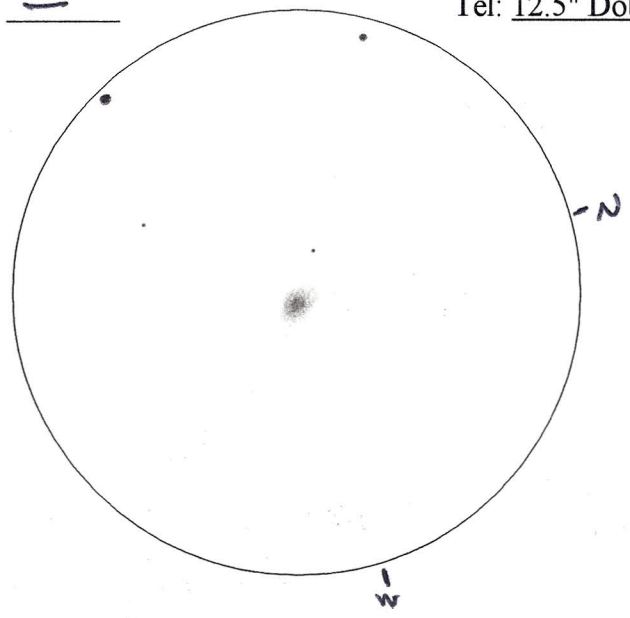
Small and dim. Brighter, circular core with stellar nucleus and dim halo.

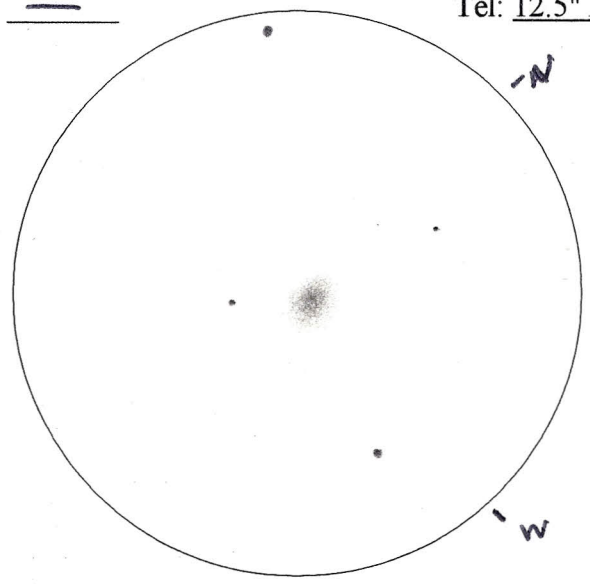
Circular halo with brighter, circular core and faint, starlike nucleus. NGC 3641 is a smaller fainter glow just to the ssw.

Nearly circular glow. Slightly elongated NNE/ssw, becoming gradually brighter toward the center. Faint, nearly stellar nucleus.
