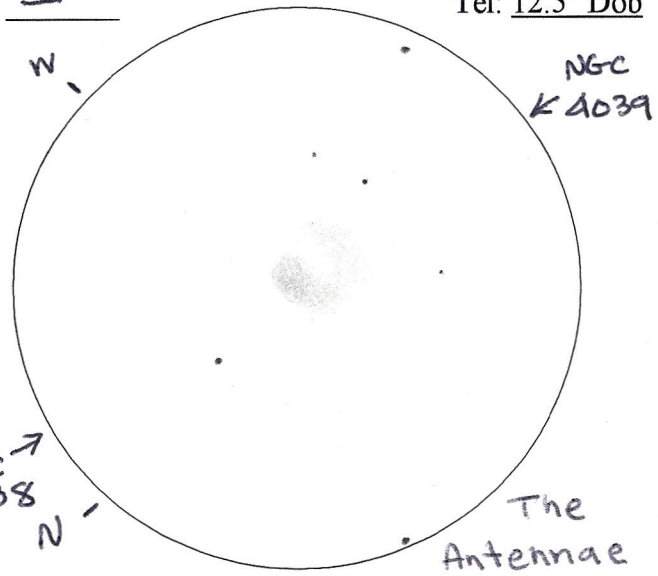


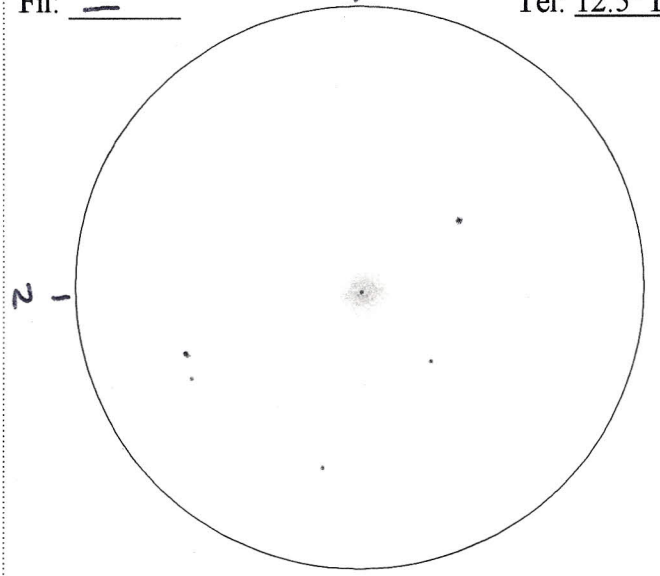

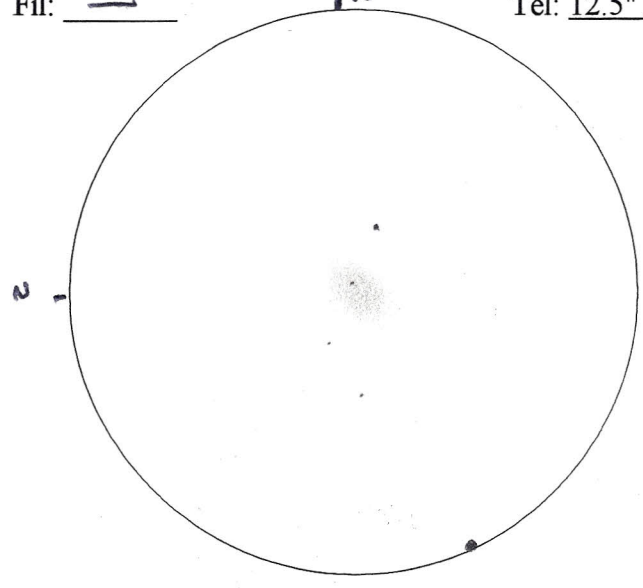
NGC 4038 is prominent and comma shaped. Becoming gradually brighter toward the center. NGC 4039 is much fainter completing the "C" shape open to the west.
