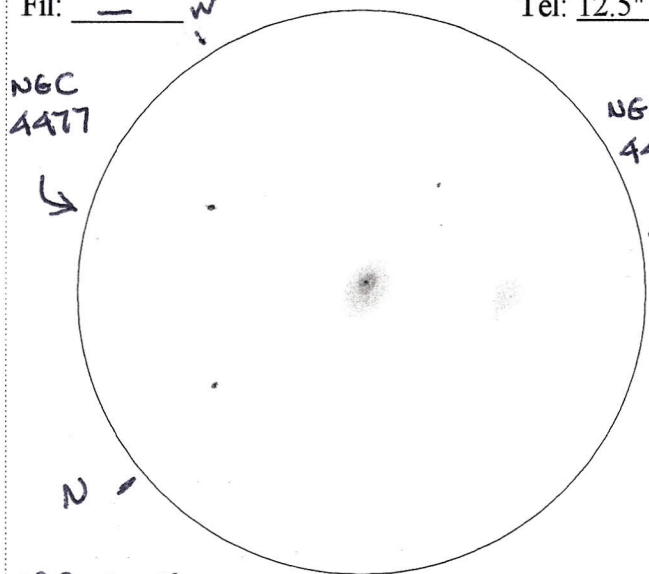
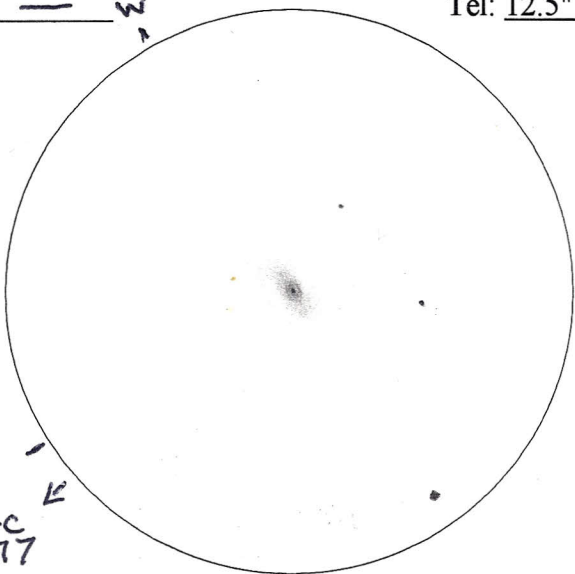


Large oval and diffuse halo elongated somewhat N/S w/ stellar nucleus. Becoming gradually brighter toward the center.
