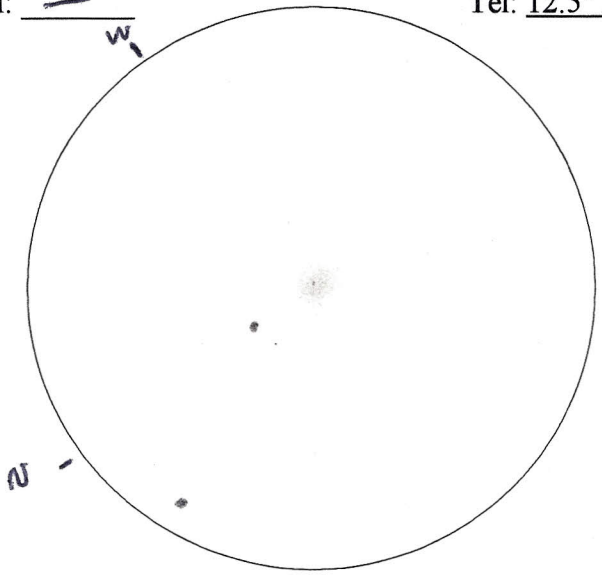


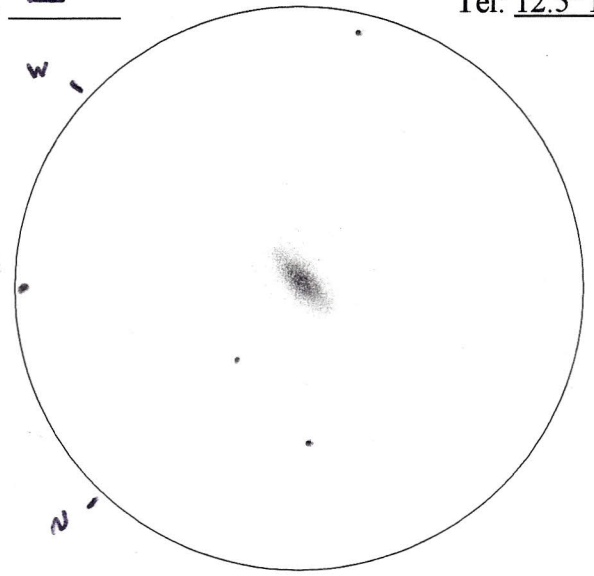

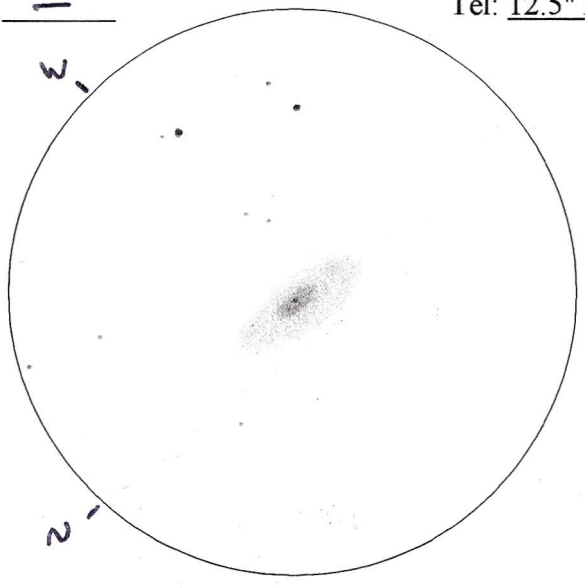
Faint, circular and diffuse.

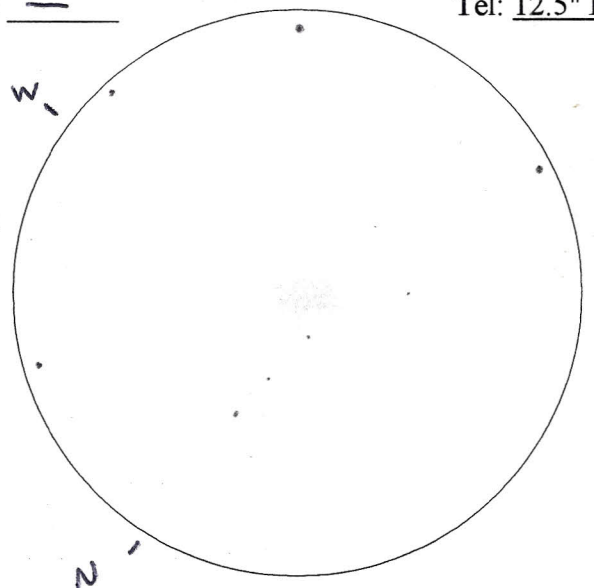
Averted vision reveals a dim
