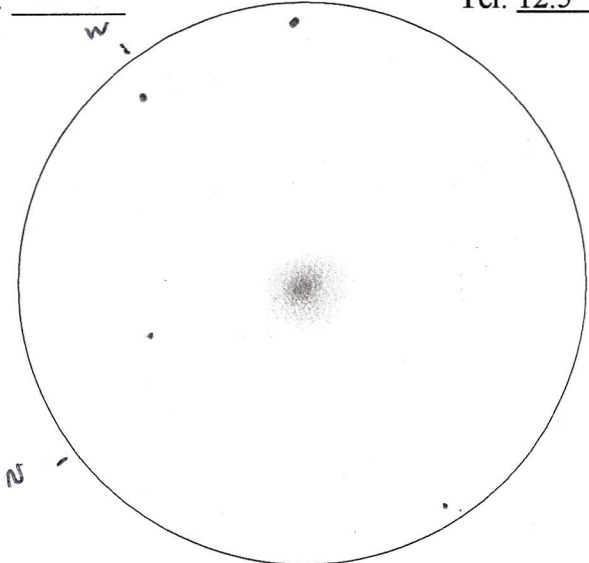
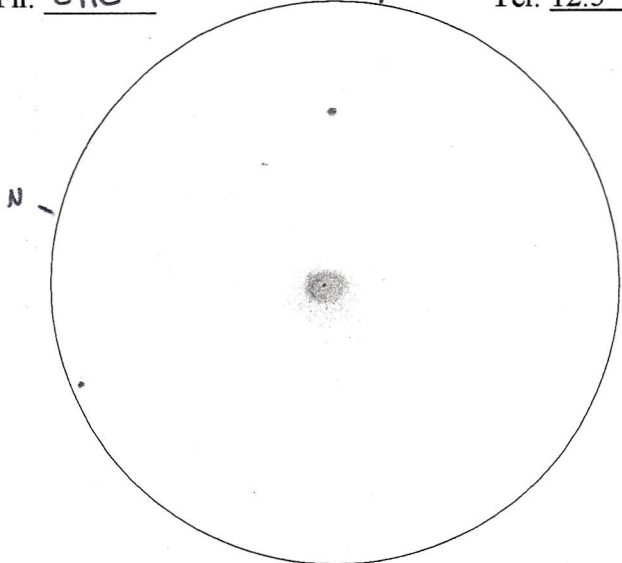

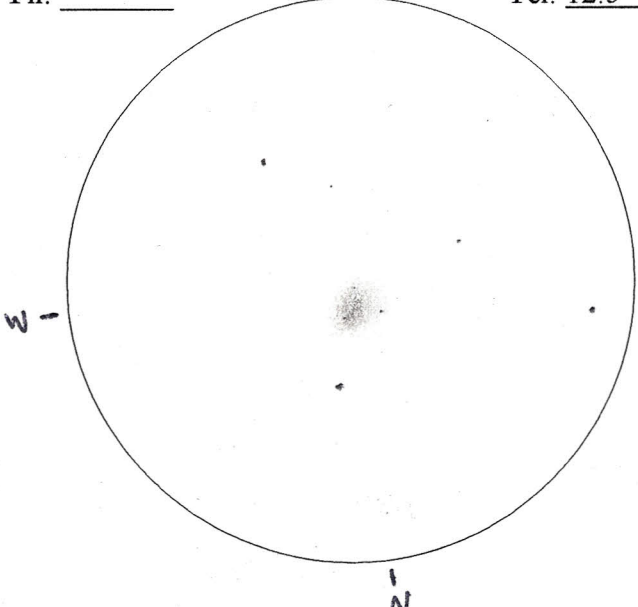
Grainy but unresolved. A large, bright core becoming gradually brighter toward the center surrounded by a dim, nebulous halo.

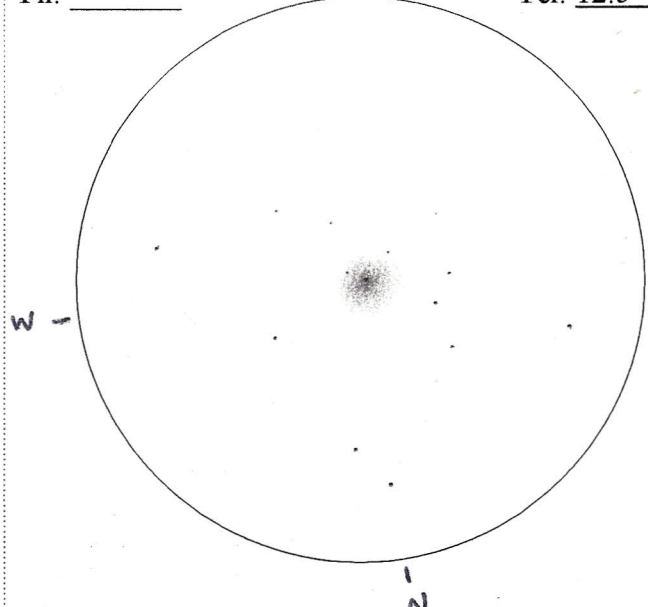
Bright, almost starlike at lower powers. Distinctly elongated NNE/SSW, central star prominent, especially at lower powers. Donut or ring shape, brighter to the north. A very faint hazy halo surrounding the bright core. Bluish in color.
