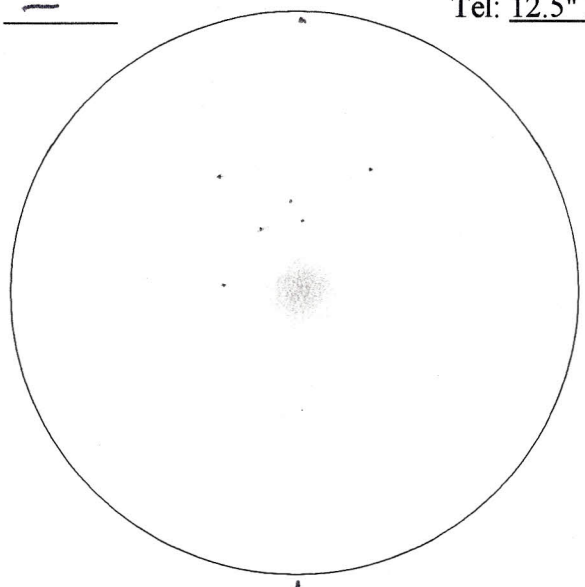


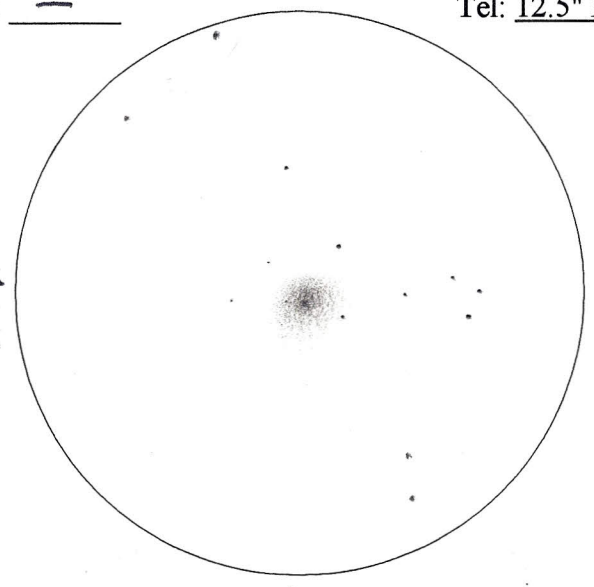

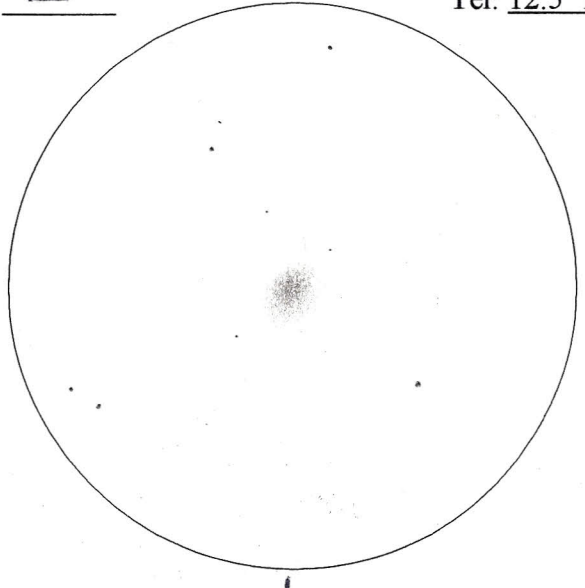
A dim, circular puff of smoke. Evenly bright throughout, Not resolvable. Small.

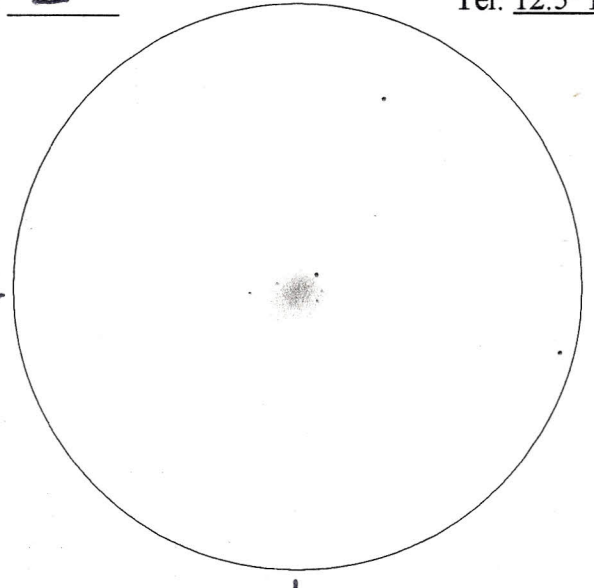
Fairly bright. Basically circular. Core brighter w/ nearly starlike nucleus. Core grainy.
