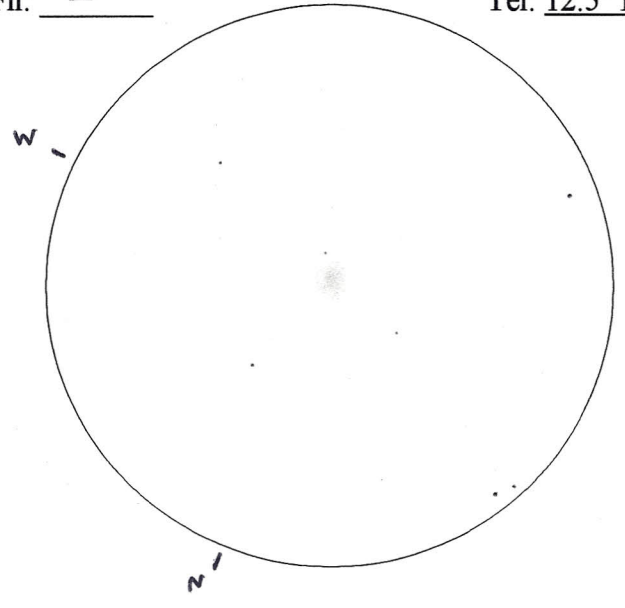


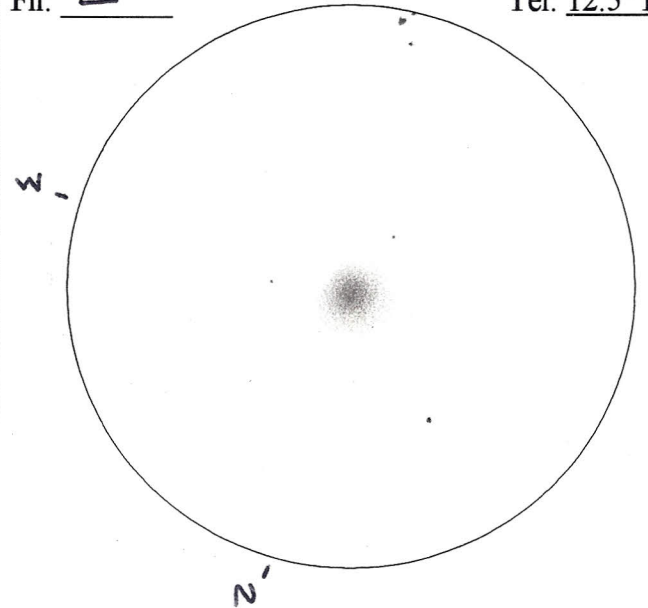

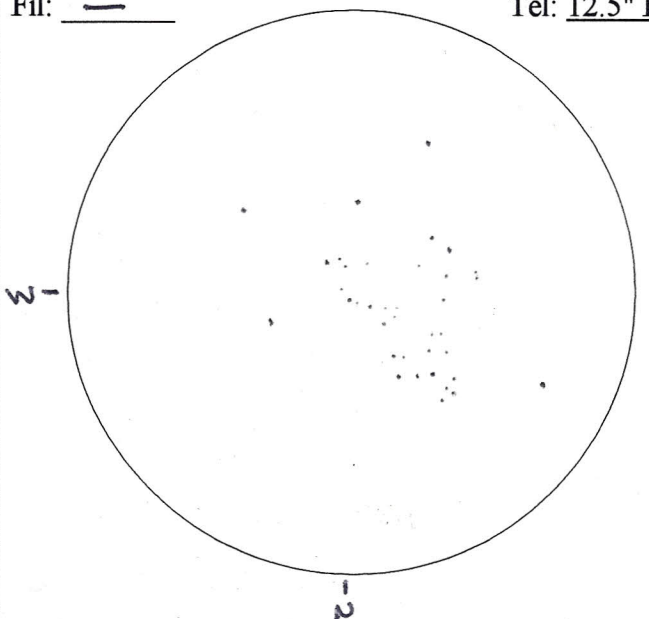
Small, dim, unresolved. A faint field star to the SW, becoming brighter toward the center,

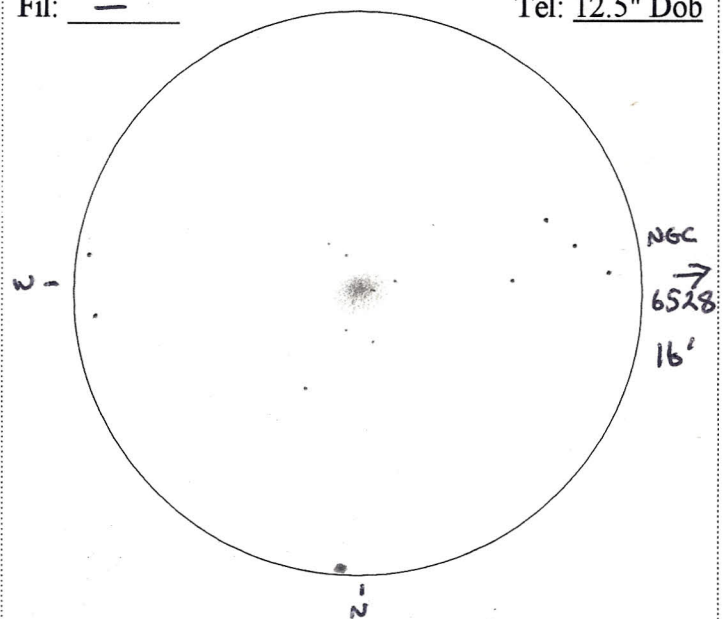
Fairly large and bright, becomes gradually brighter toward the center with extensive core. Unresolved.
