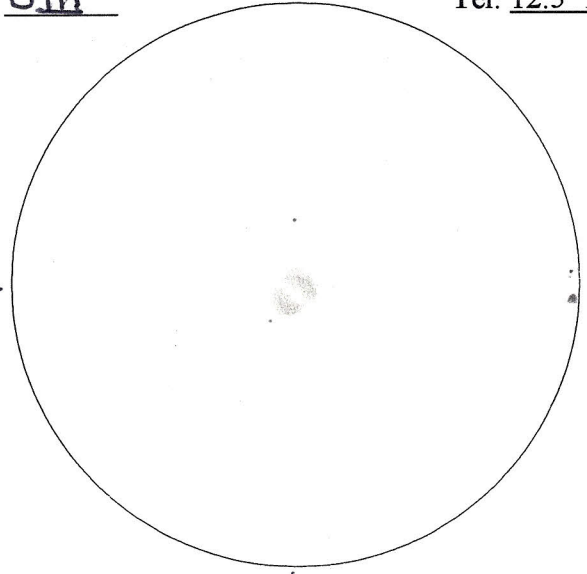


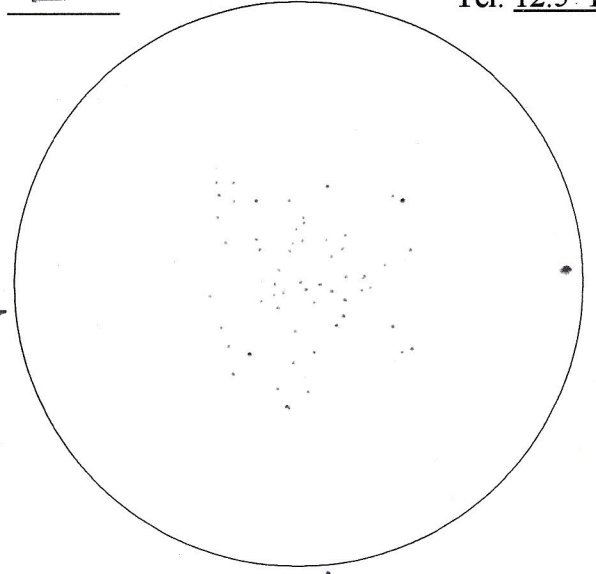

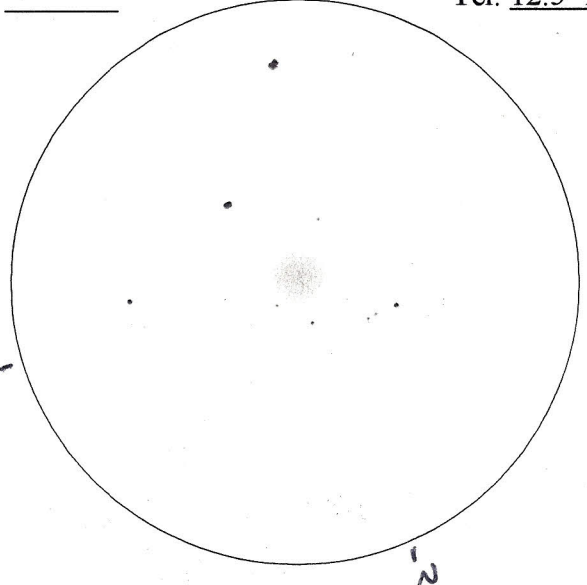
Small and dim. Basically ring shaped, but with brighter NW and SE halves. No central star seen.

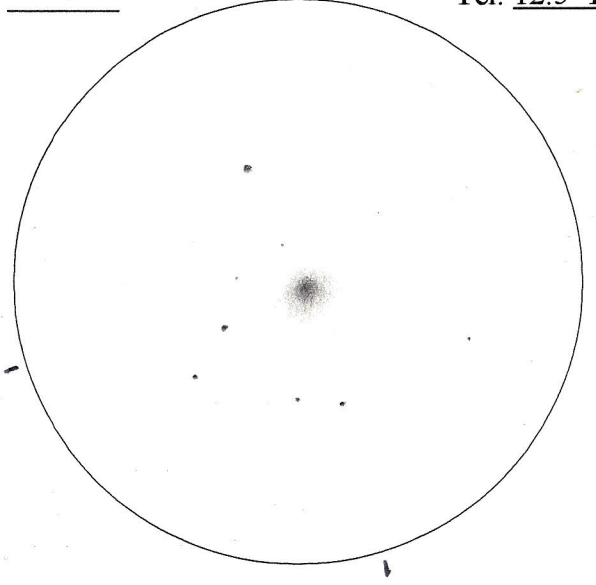
A loosely concentrated cluster with a "C" shaped asterism near the center and opening to the NW. Brighter star just East of the cluster.

Fairly large but faint. Becoming only slightly brighter toward the center. Unresolved

Faint outer halo surrounding large core which becomes gradually brighter, then suddenly brighter with nearly starlike nucleus.
