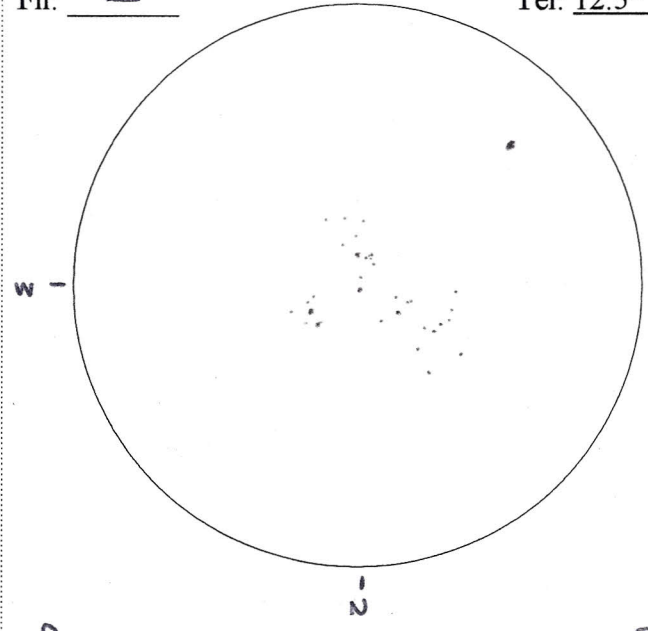
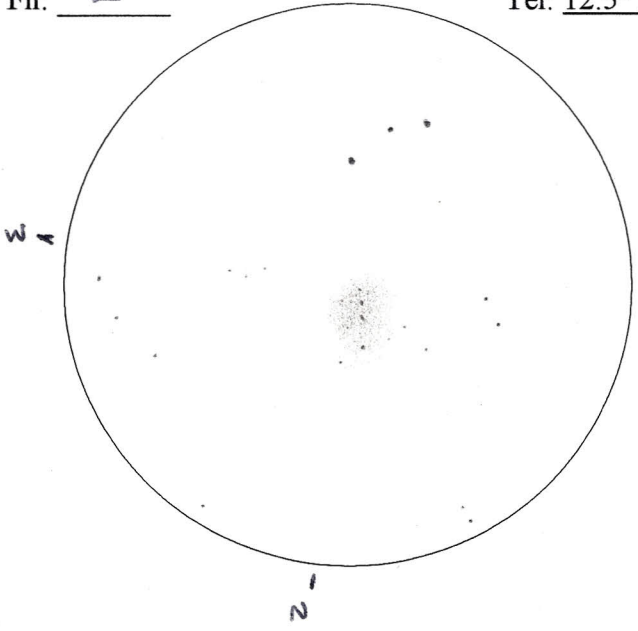

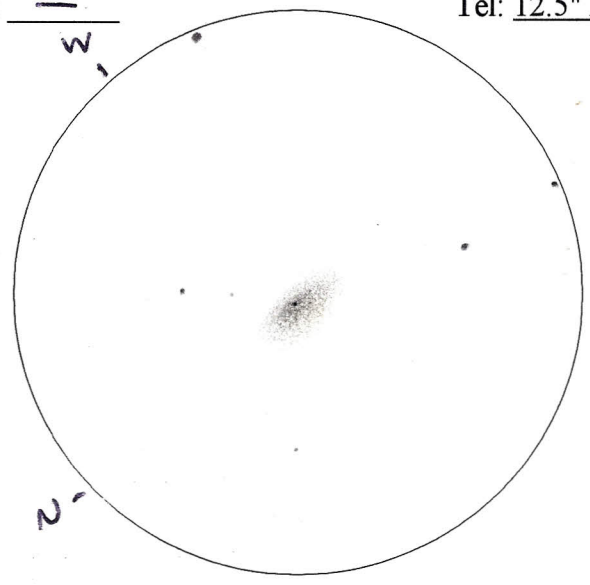
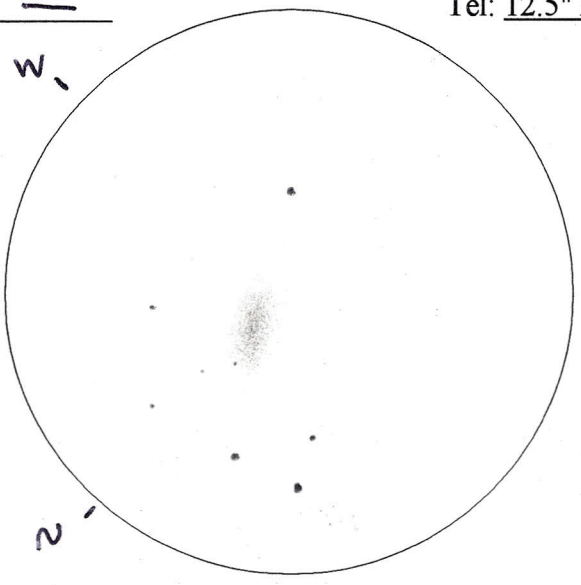


A small faint cluster consisting of a few faint stars against an unresolved background. A string of four stars running WSW/ESE near the center.
