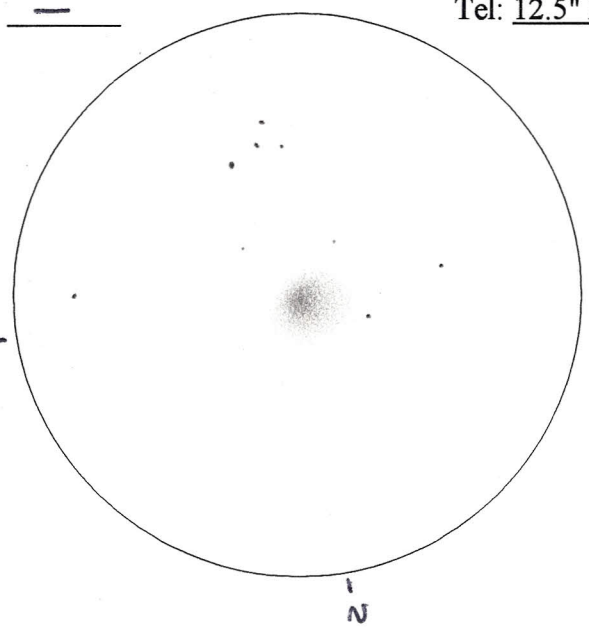


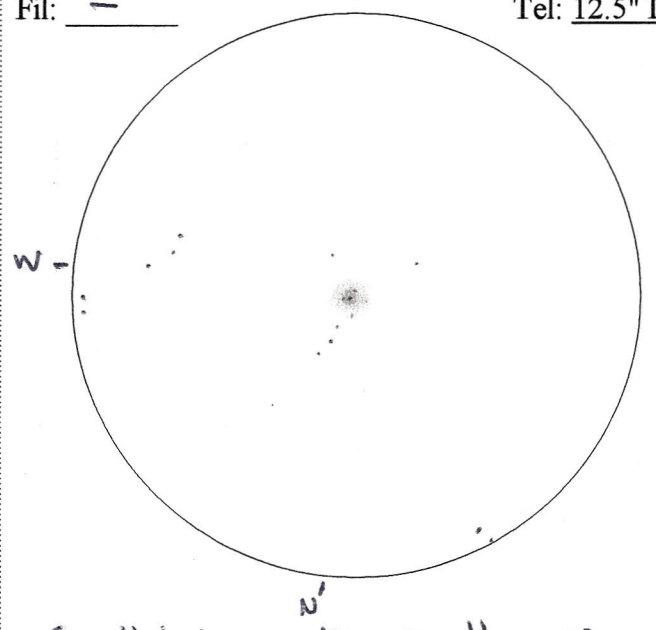

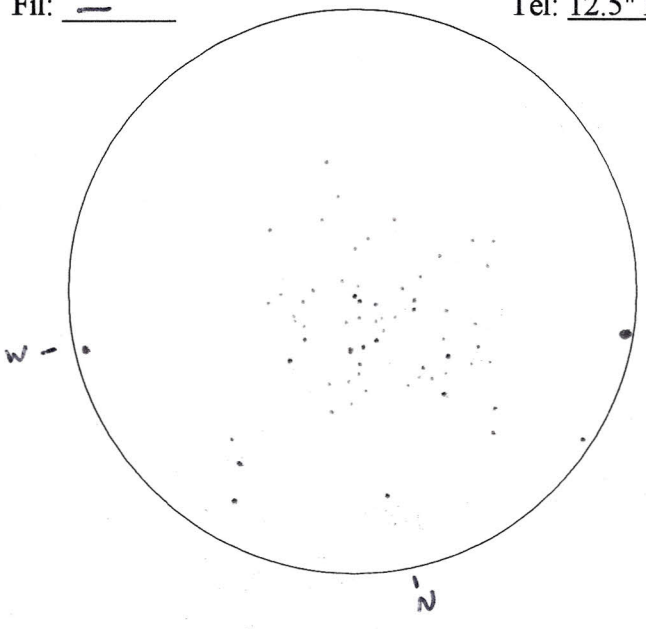
Fairly large and bright, becoming gradually brighter toward the center with mottled core,

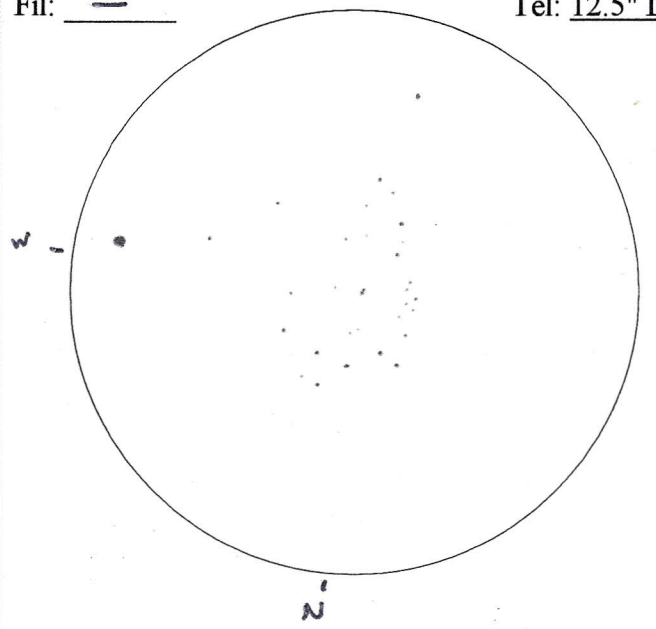
Small & dim with small core and dim but starlike nucleus. A few stars resolvable in the halo.
