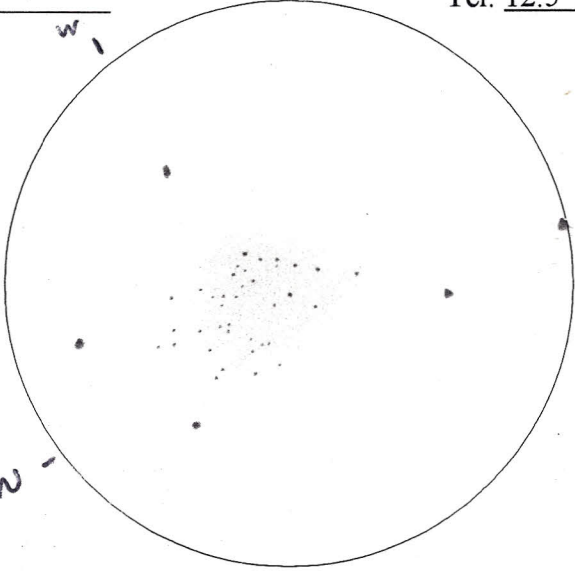
Fairly large & bright. Round. Becoming gradually brighter toward the center but lacking a bright nucleus. Unresolved but grainy in appearance.

A very nice cluster with two brighter members near the center running NW-SE. A "Y" shaped chain of moderate stars marks the center. Dimmer stars sprinkled throughout.

A very rich cluster. Fairly concentrated with an unresolved background of faint stars. A string of brighter stars runs N/W-S/E on the SW side of the cluster.
