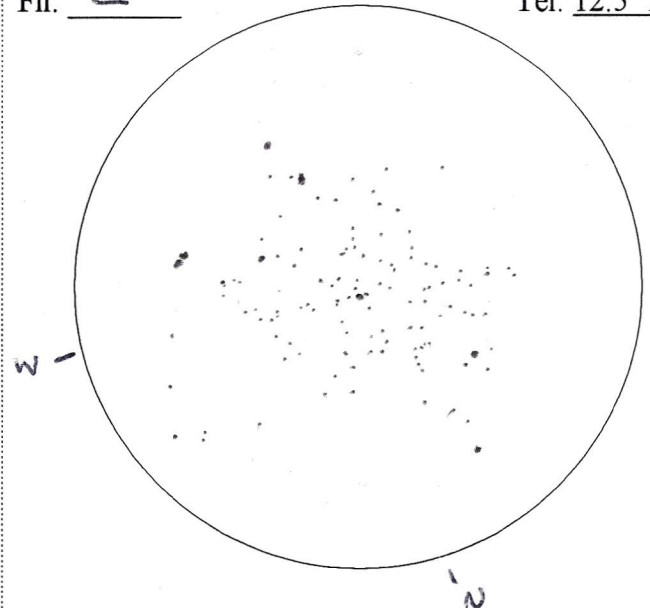


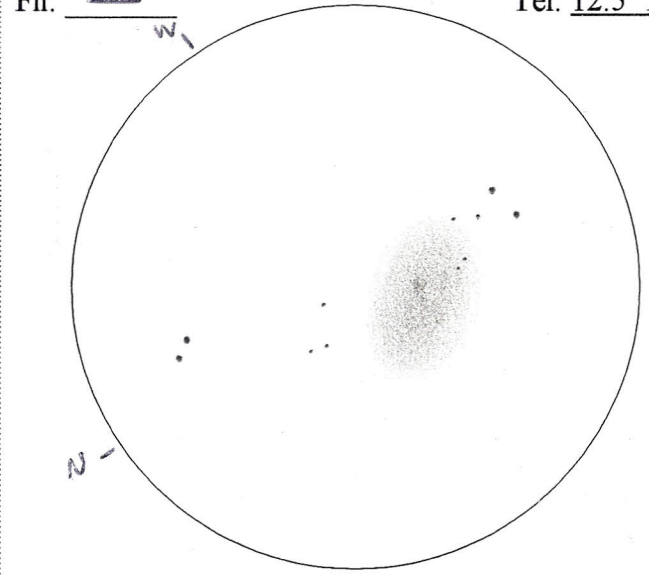

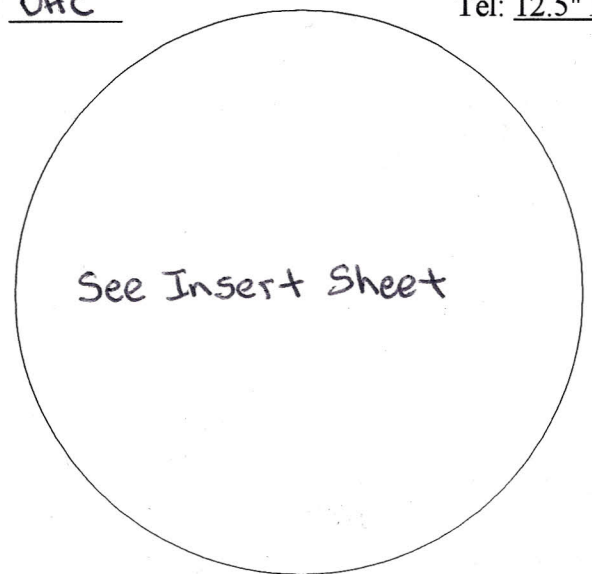
A large and very rich cluster, with a moderately bright orange-red star near the center. A bright parallelogram of stars to the SW.

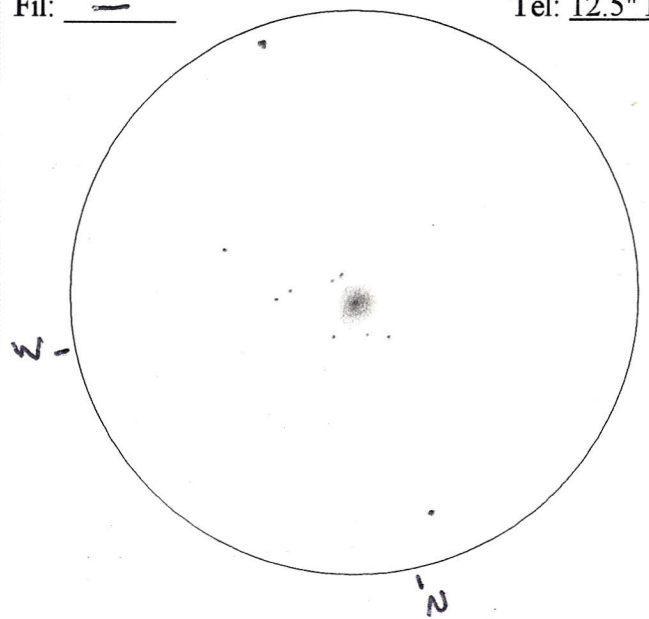
Large, diffuse, low surface brightness. Elongated NE/SW with small, dim core.
