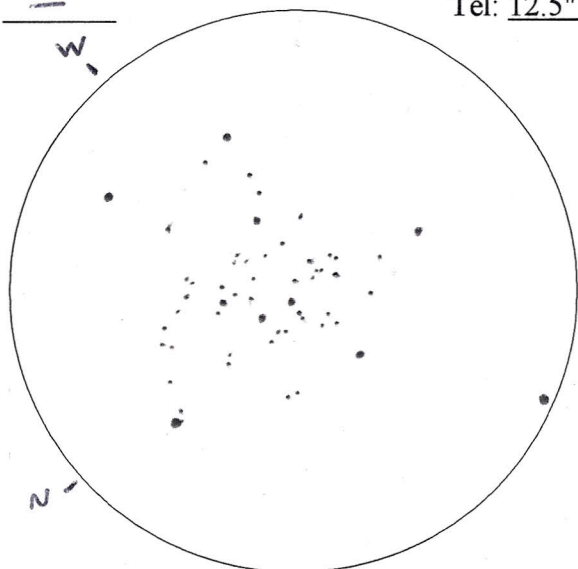


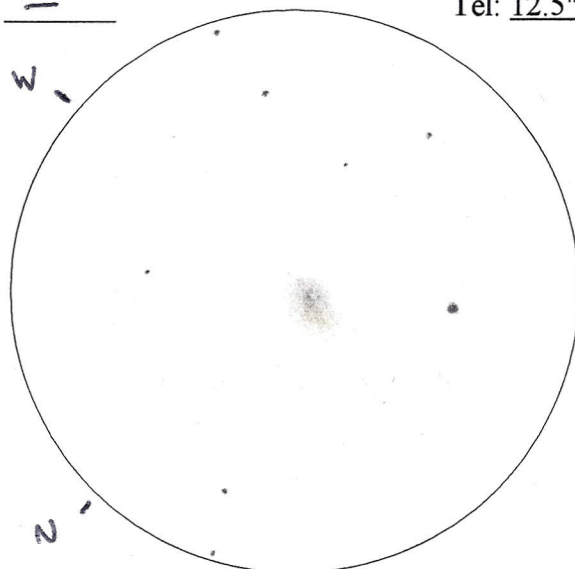

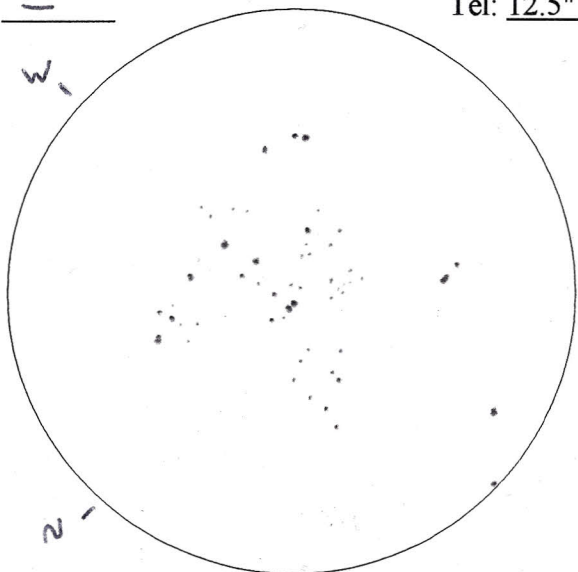
Fairly large, loose, sprawling cluster. Many bright stars. Framed by five bright field stars.

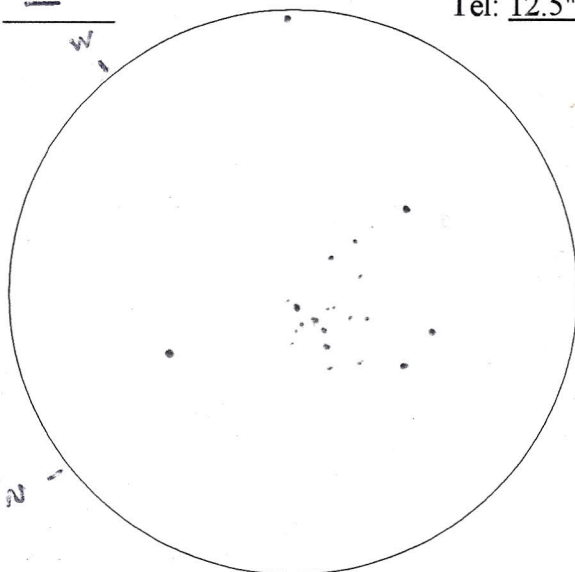
Faint, becoming slightly brighter toward the center. Elongated E/W. Faint core.

A large, spread-out cluster w/ little to no concentration. A curve of brighter stars on the NW side forms a parabola open to the NE. A double star near the center. (Z2890)
