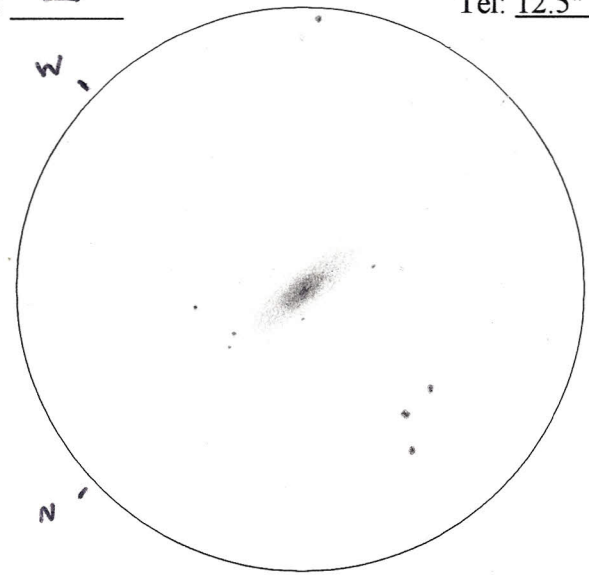


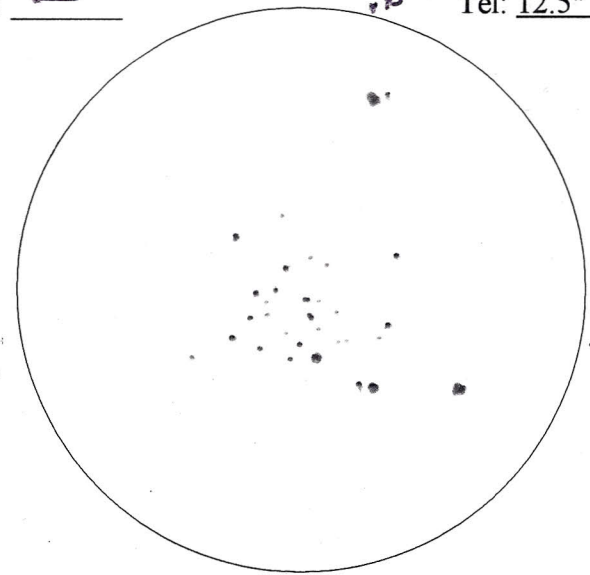

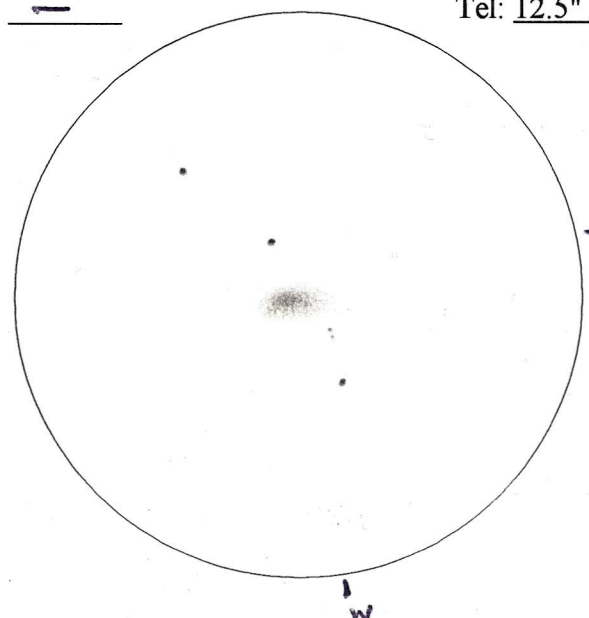
A large, bright galaxy, very elongated N/S. Halo very extended w/ bright elongated core and starlike nucleus. A very nice galaxy.

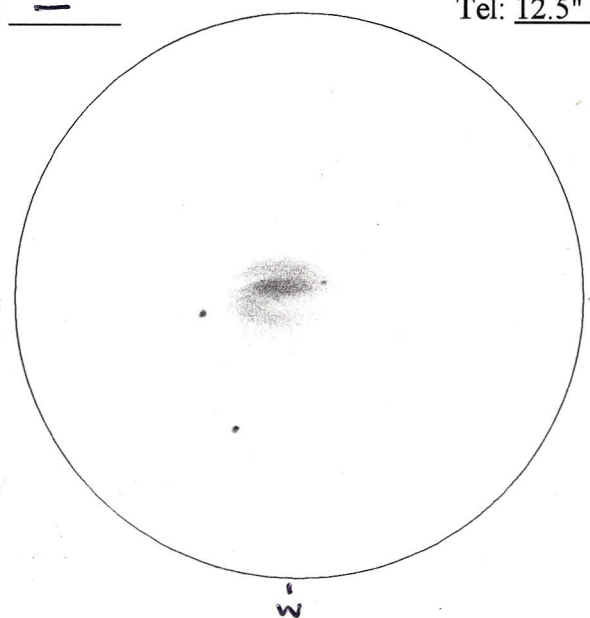
A large, fairly bright cluster, triangular in shape. Outlined by 8-10 bright stars w/ many dimmer stars interspersed. A Caroline Herschel discovery.

Halo elongated NNW/SSE with somewhat brighter, elongated core. No nucleus visible. A smudge of light. Brighter than expected.

Larger, diffuse halo, somewhat elongated N/S, brighter to the East and SW. Brighter elongated core (N/S). No nucleus. Low surface brightness overall.
