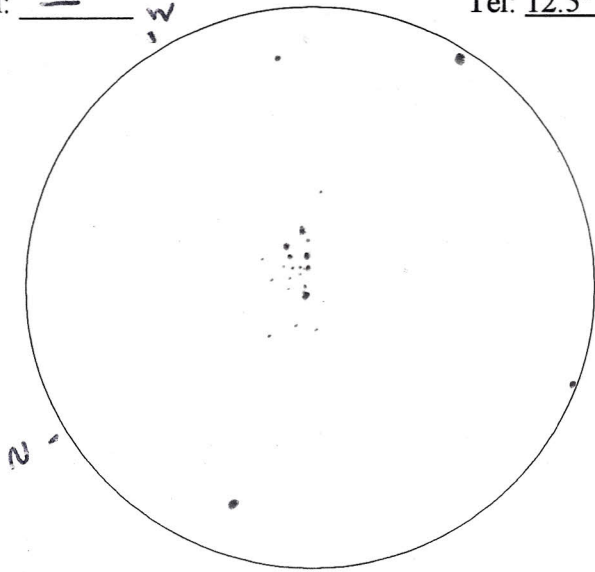


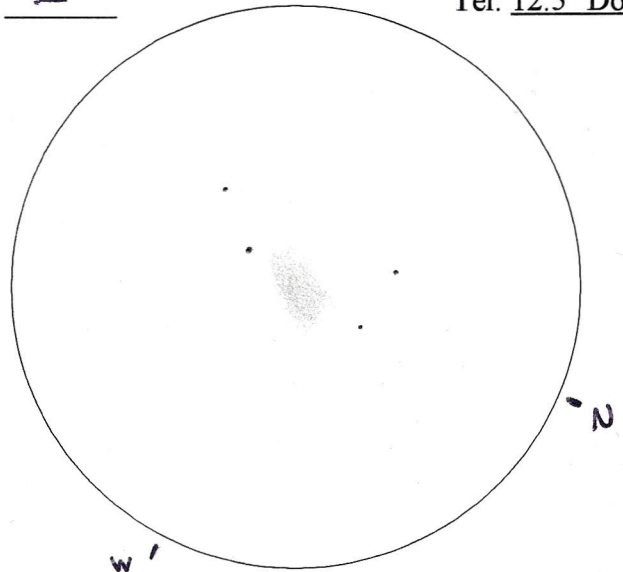

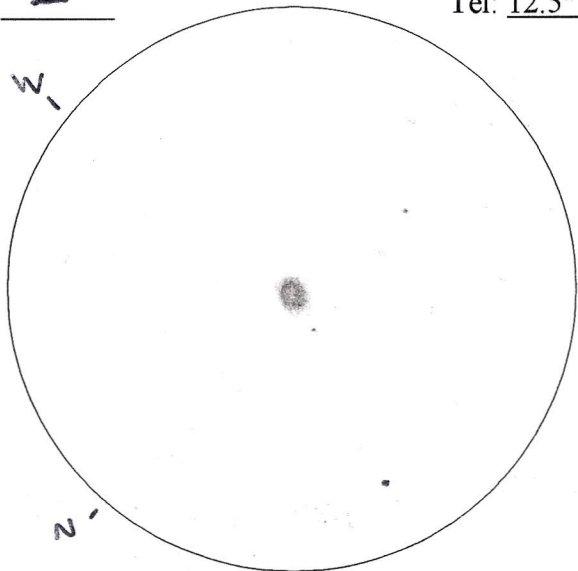
A nice little wedge-shaped cluster. Bright and rich despite its small size.

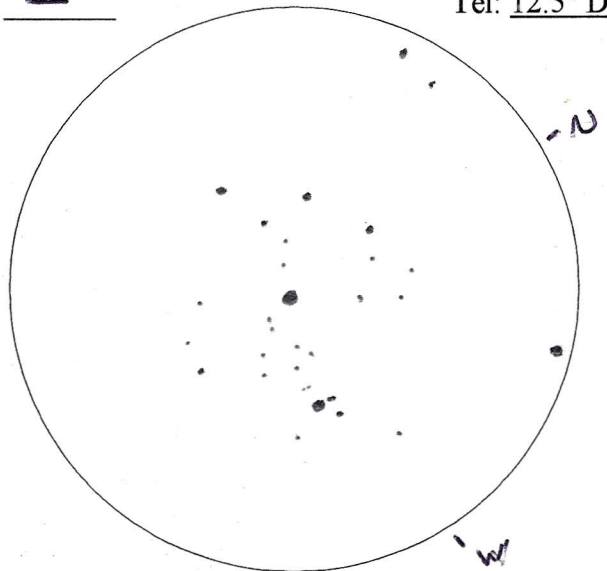
Low surface brightness. Dim, elongated glow, between two pairs of dim stars, low in the ESE.
