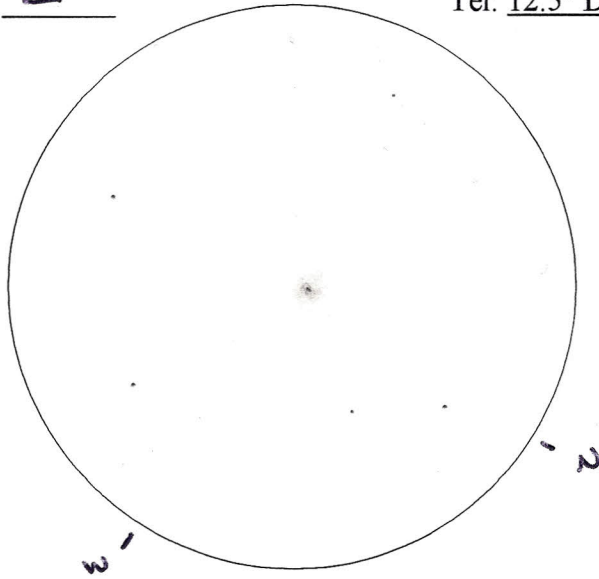


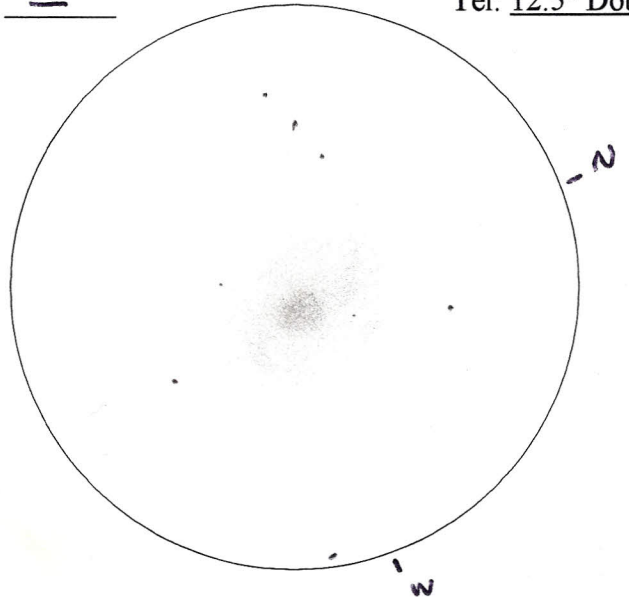

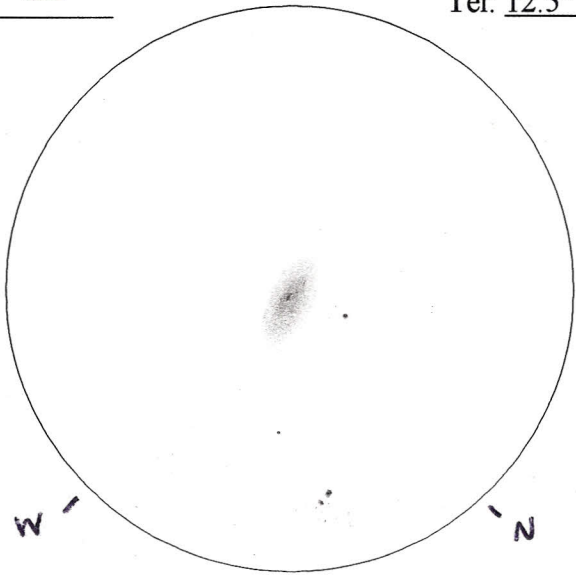
Small, round halo w/ brighter stellar nucleus.

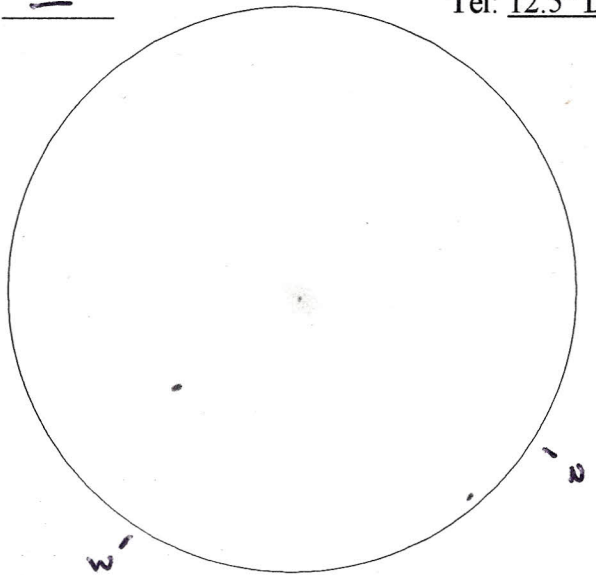
A very large, very low surface brightness galaxy w/ extended dim halo. Core suddenly brighter. Slightly elongated N/S. Hint of mottling in halo.
