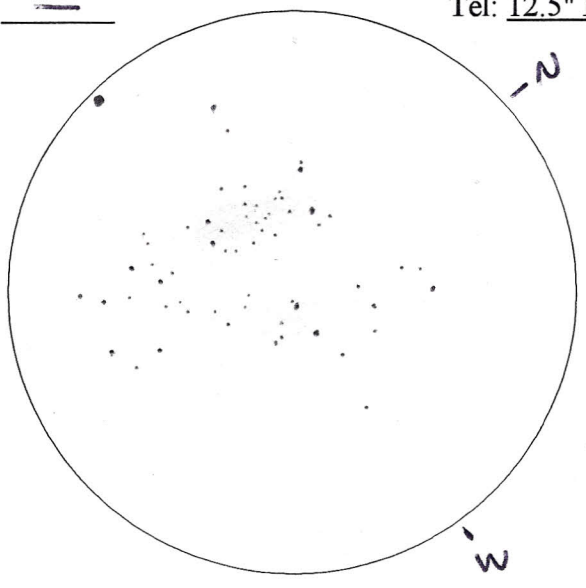


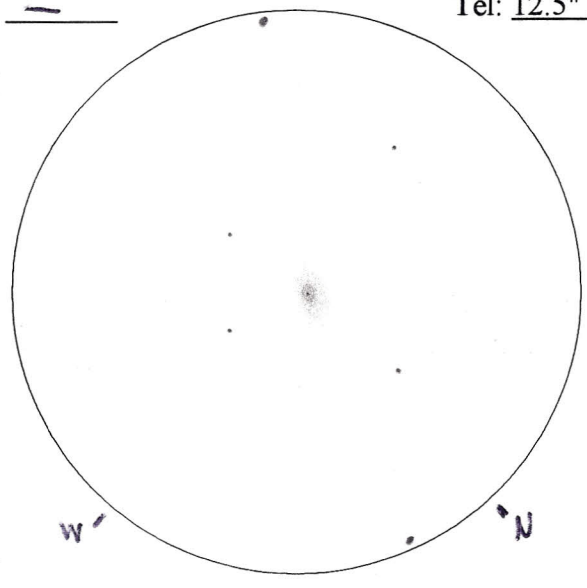

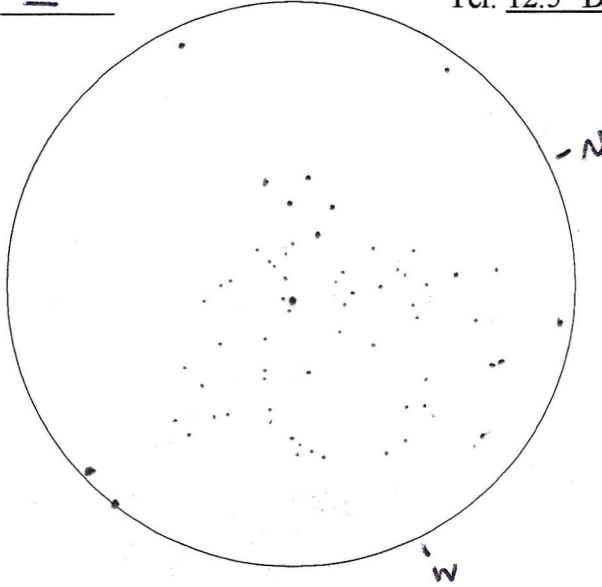
A beautiful, large & rich cluster, divided into an eastern band (richer) and a western band.

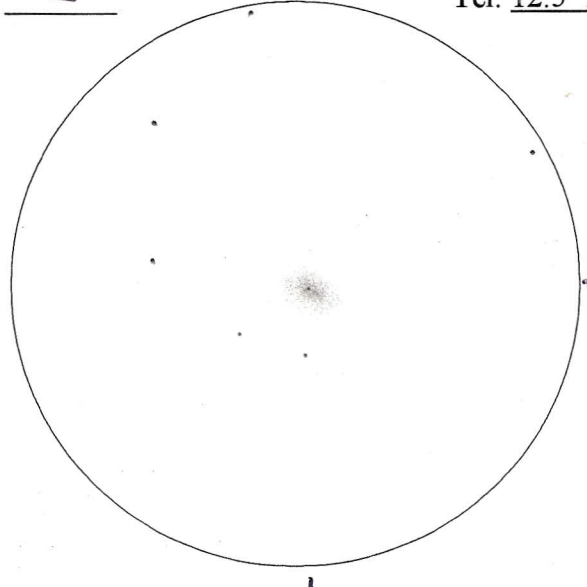
Small, dim galaxy. Halo fuzzy and slightly elongated. Bright core w/ very dim stellar nucleus.

A very large cluster. Rich, with many strings and loops of stars. A nice double along the NW edge.
