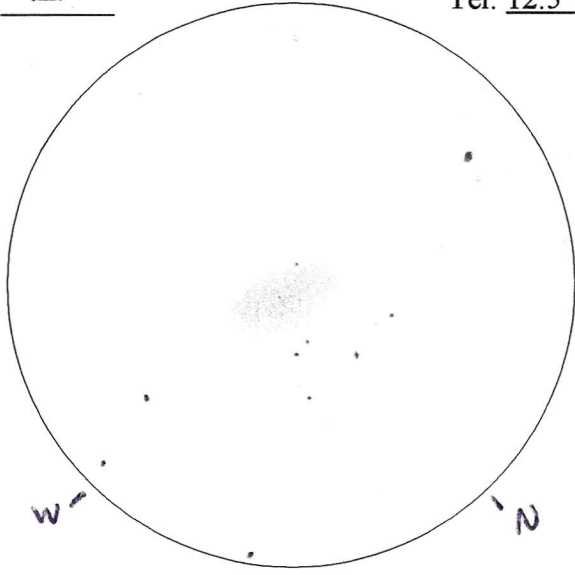


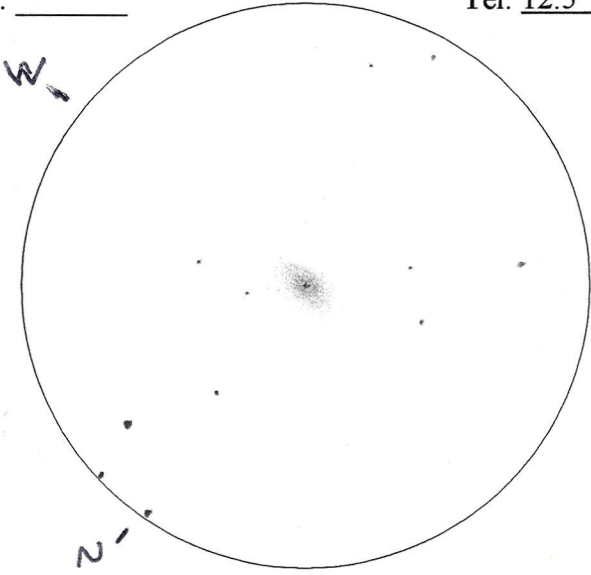

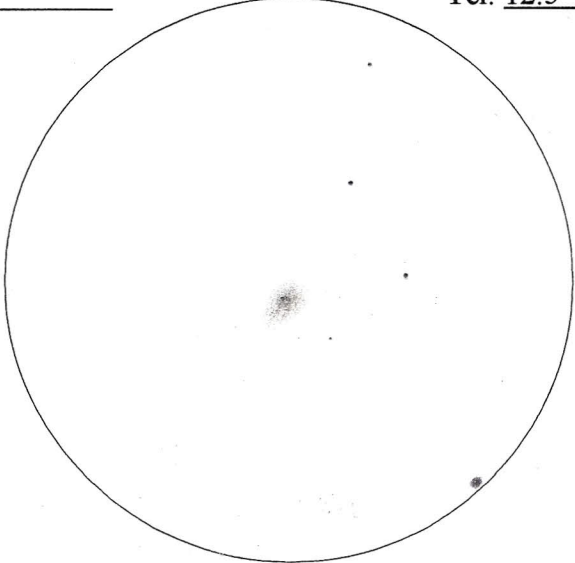
A large, oval cloud, elongated WSW/ENE, Even in brightness. Two dim stars embedded. One just west of center and the other on the ESE edge.

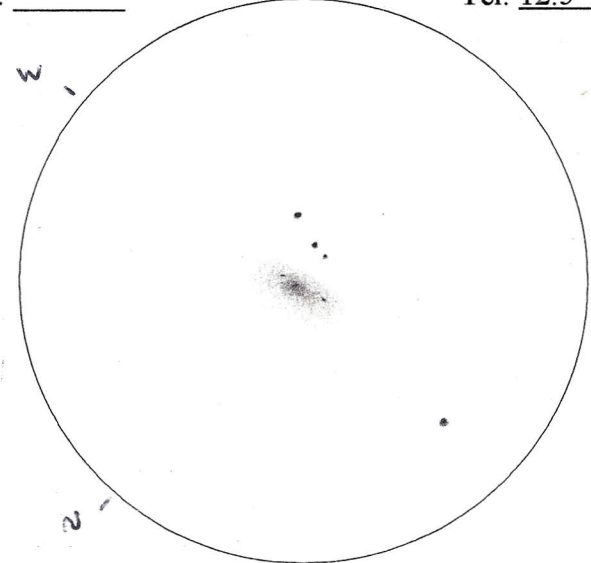
Halo elongated somewhat E/W. Brighter round core w/ starlike nucleus. Overall, fairly dim.

A small, round smudge of soft light, slightly brighter toward the center with a faint starlike nucleus.

Elongated WNW - ESE. Becomes gradually, then suddenly brighter toward the center. Core bright, with bright, nearly starlike nucleus. One dim star just to the west of the nucleus, another, a little more distant, to the East.
