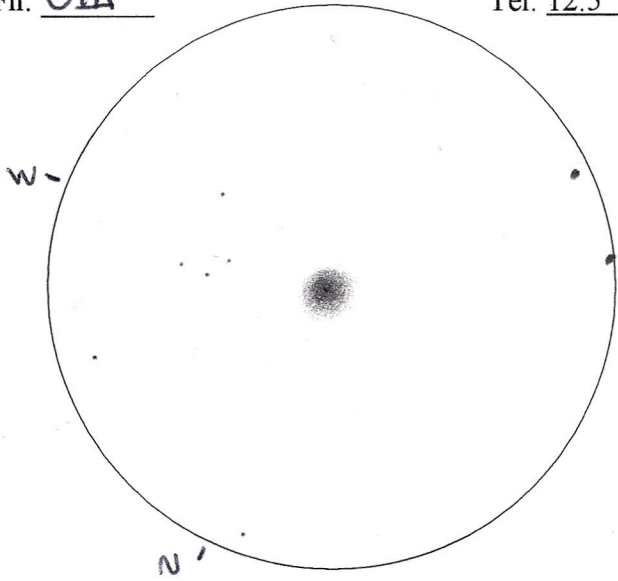
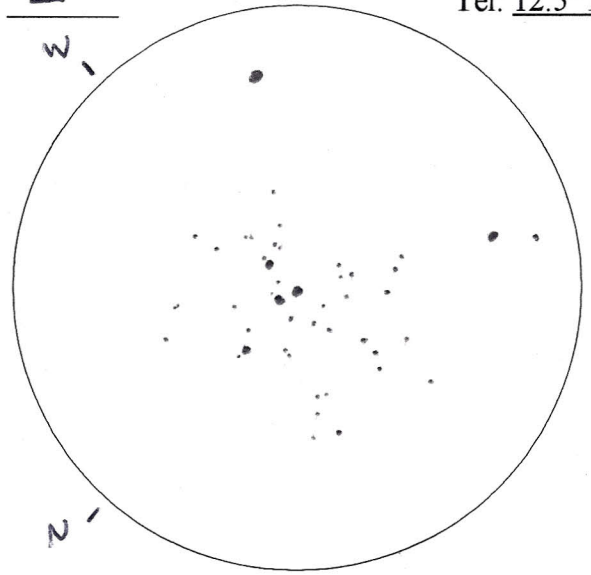

 A very nice planetary.

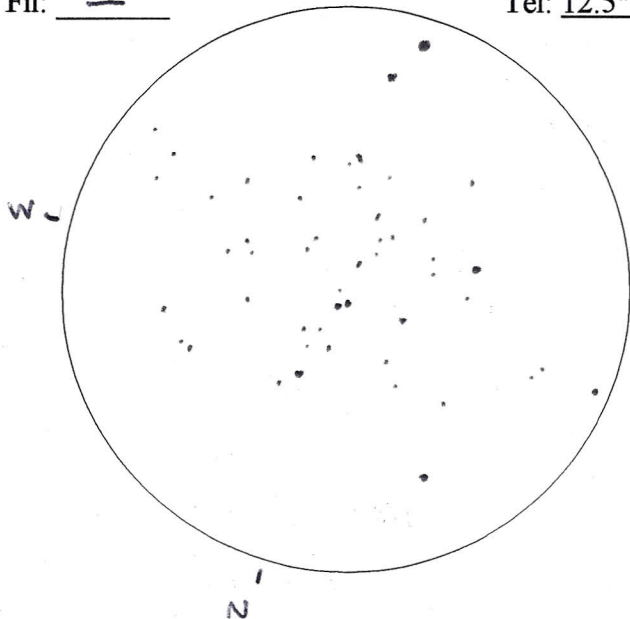

A very loose, large collection of bright & dim stars. No real concentration.

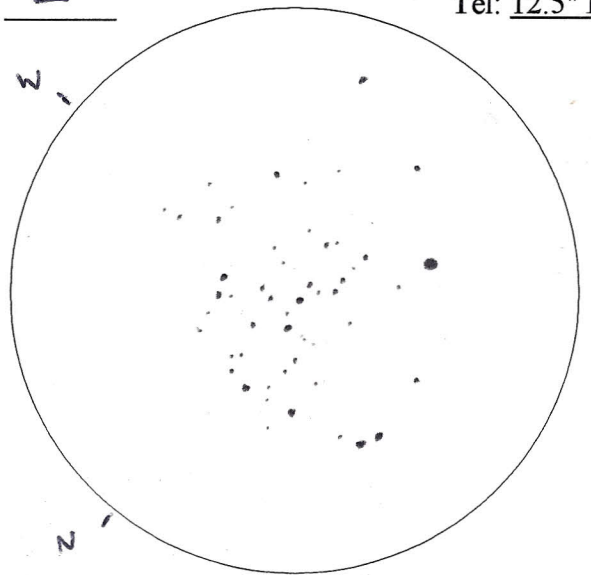
