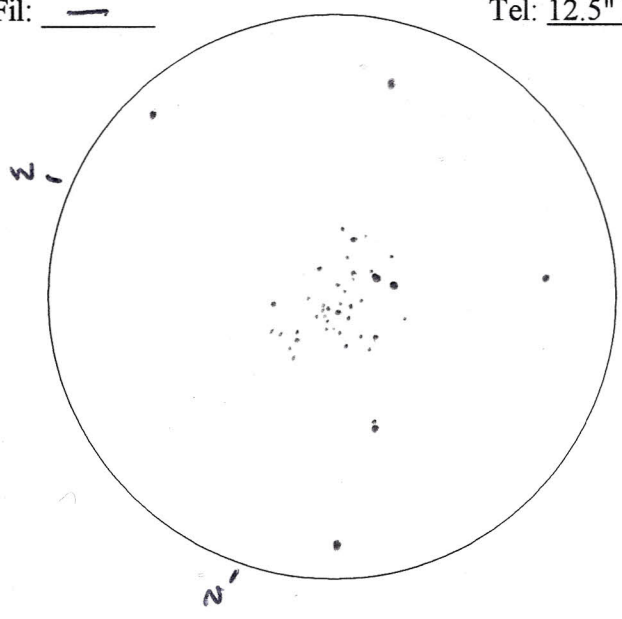


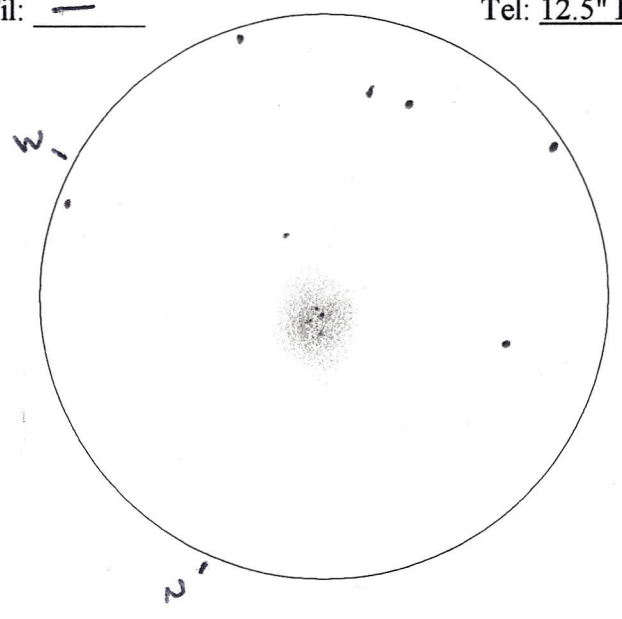

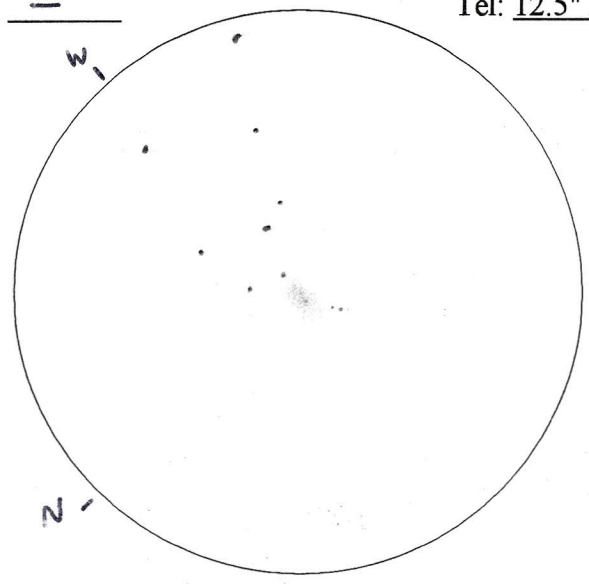
A pretty little compact cluster with a nice pair of brighter stars just to the SE of center.

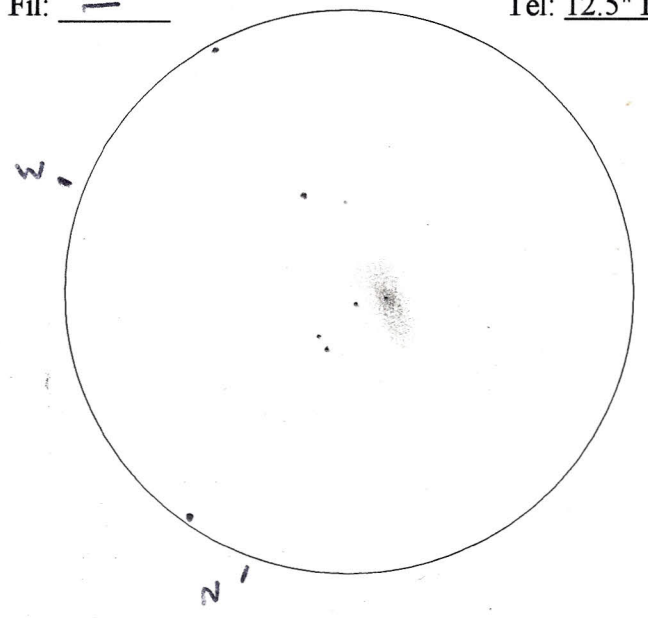
A oval hazy patch surrounding three dim stars and a slightly brighter one.
