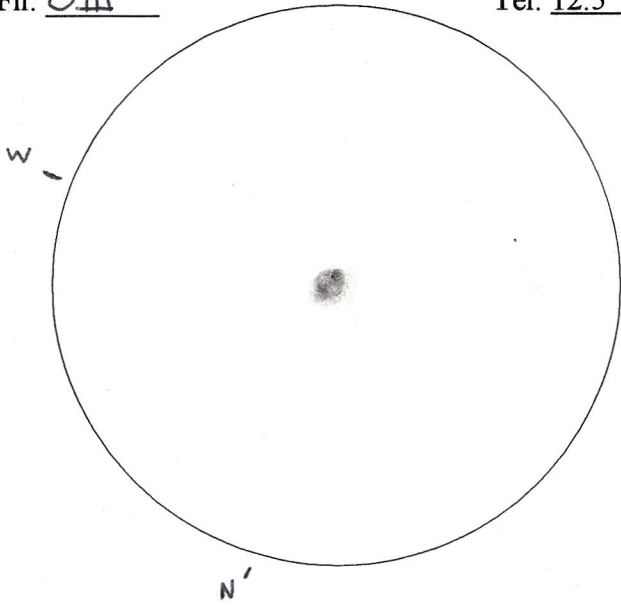
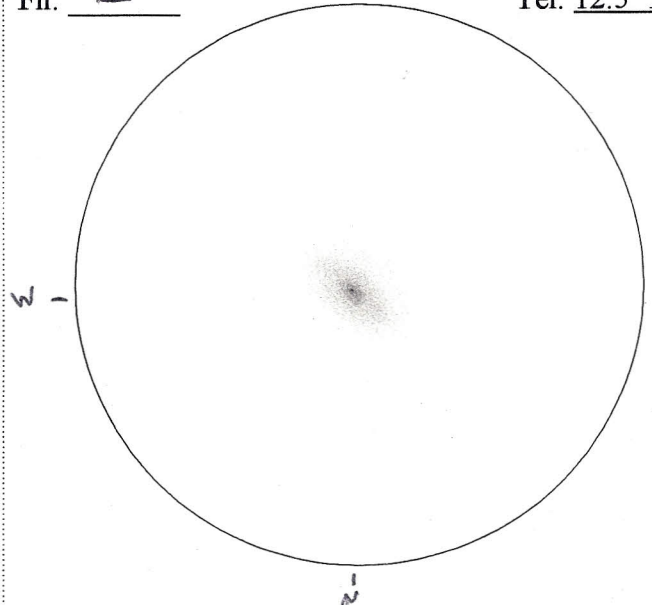

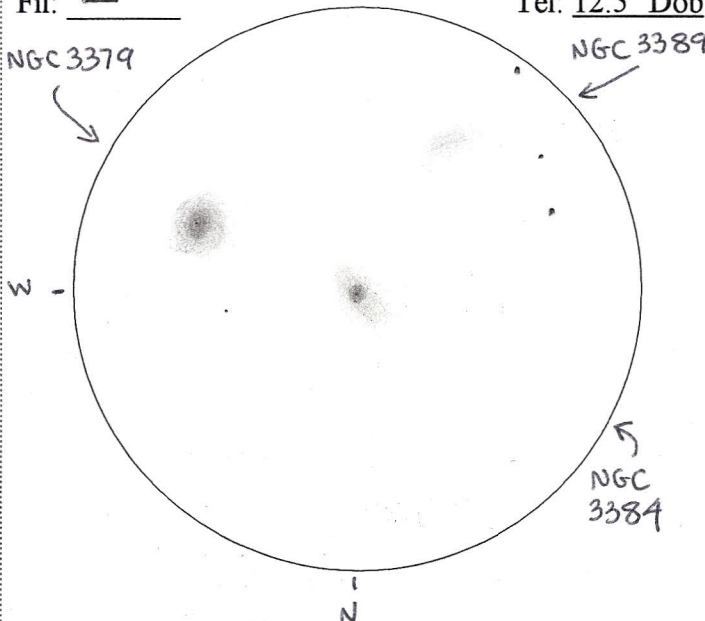
Bluish color. Basically round with brighter spots to the SSE and NNW. Dimmer spots to the WSW and ENE.

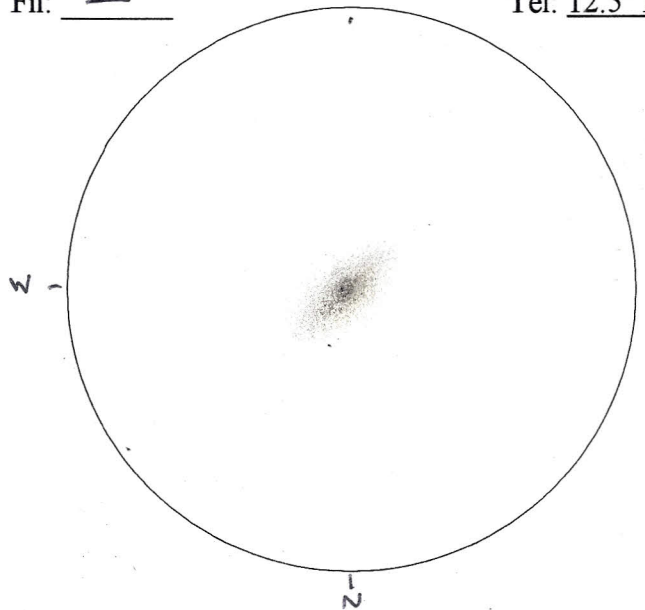
Elongated NE/SW. Vague and dim halo w/ slightly brighter core and dim starlike nucleus.

 NGC 3384: slightly dimmer. Elongated NE/SW w/ smaller, more concentrated core & starlike nucleus.  
 NGC 3389: A dim smudge, elongated ESE/WNW.
