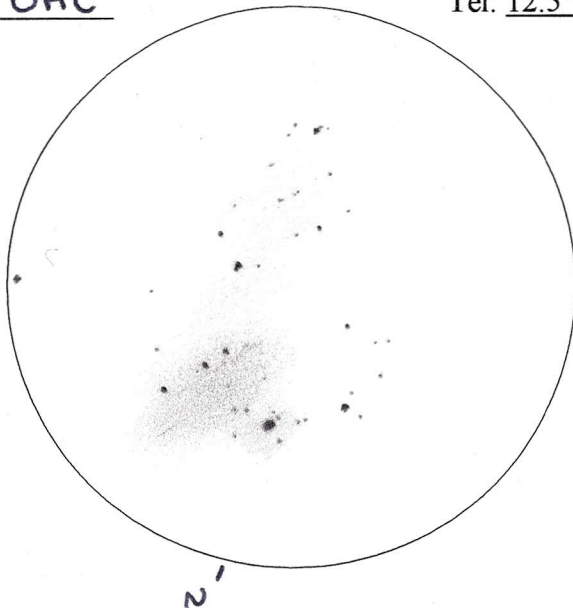
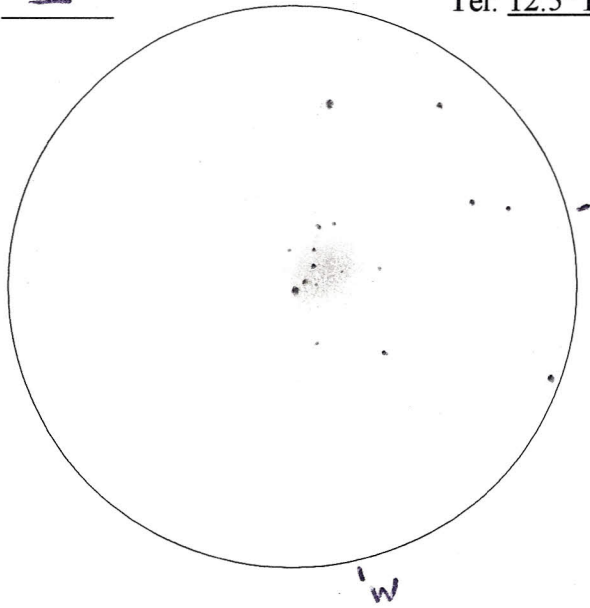

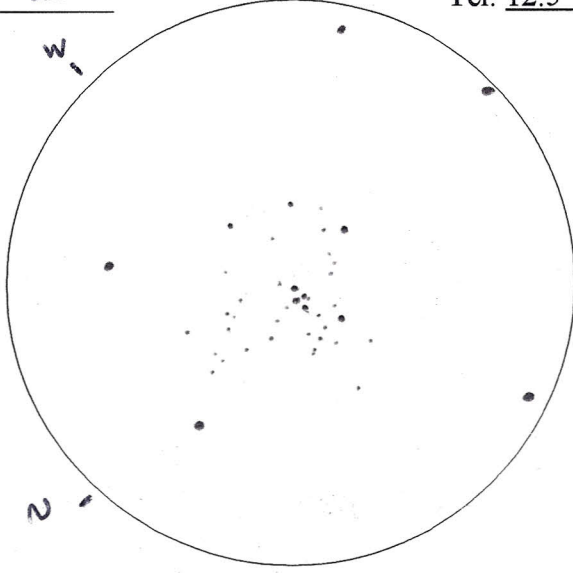

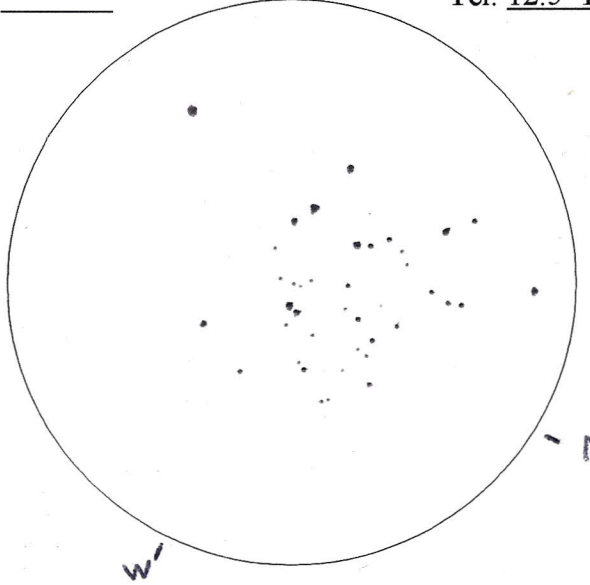
Difficult to spot. A chain of progressively dimmer stars to the ENE with a haze of unresolved dimmer stars.

A large, bright cluster. No central condensation. A diamond shaped asterism of brighter stars near the middle.
