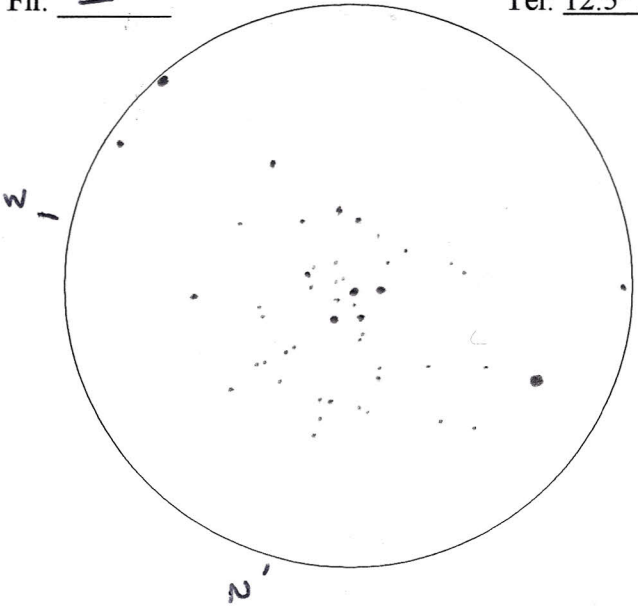


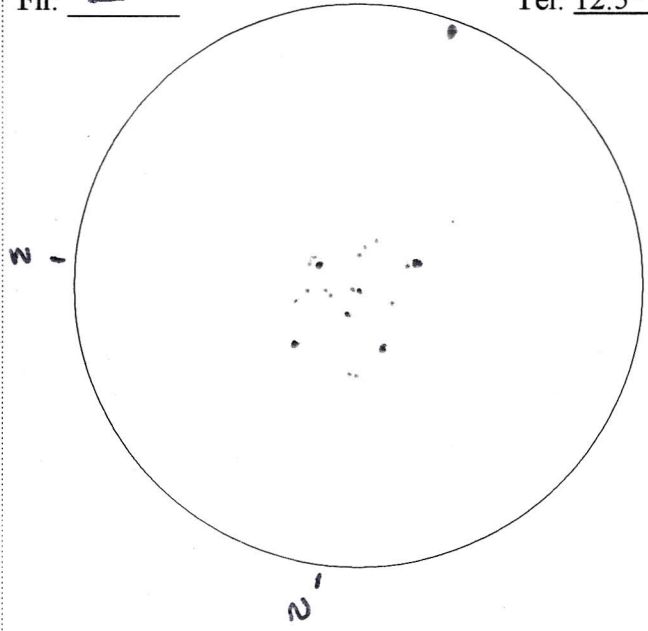

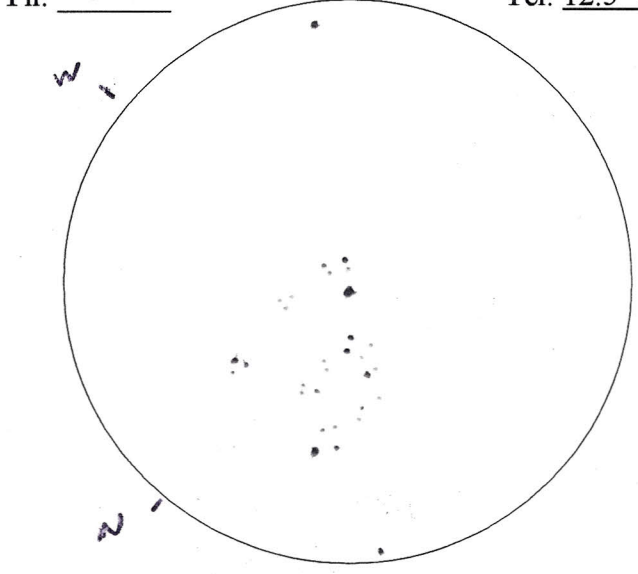
A loose cluster with a nice little parallelogram of brighter stars near the center.

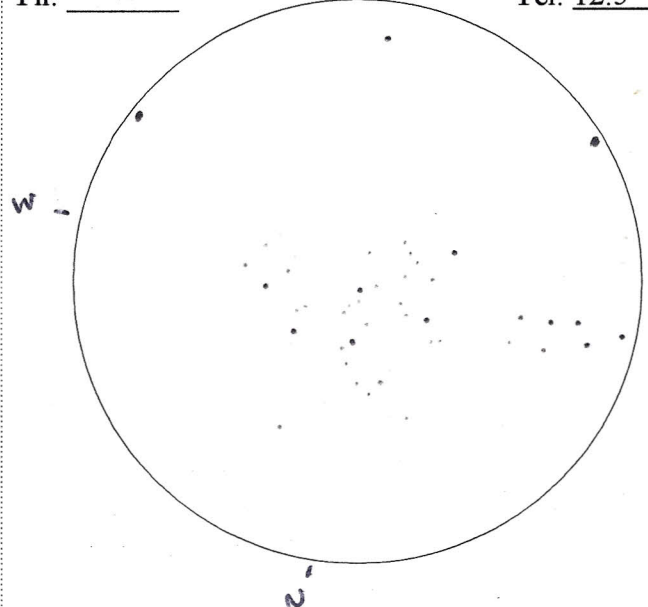
A bright cluster mostly contained within a parallelogram of slightly brighter stars. Fairly concentrated but in a rich star field.
