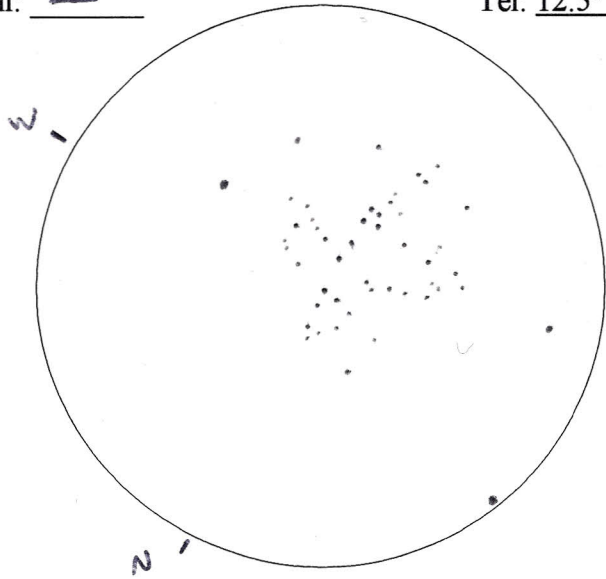


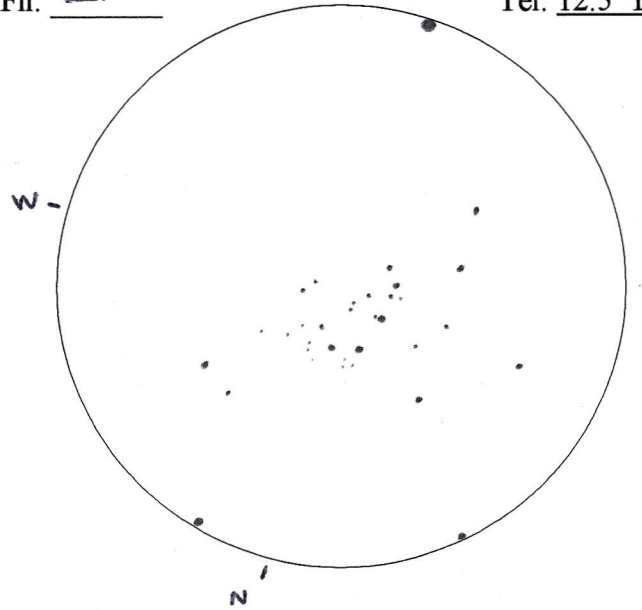

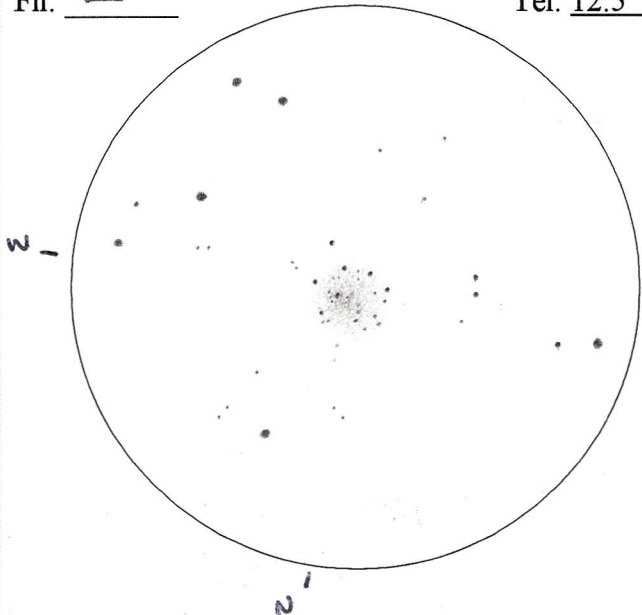
A rich cluster of dimmer stars.

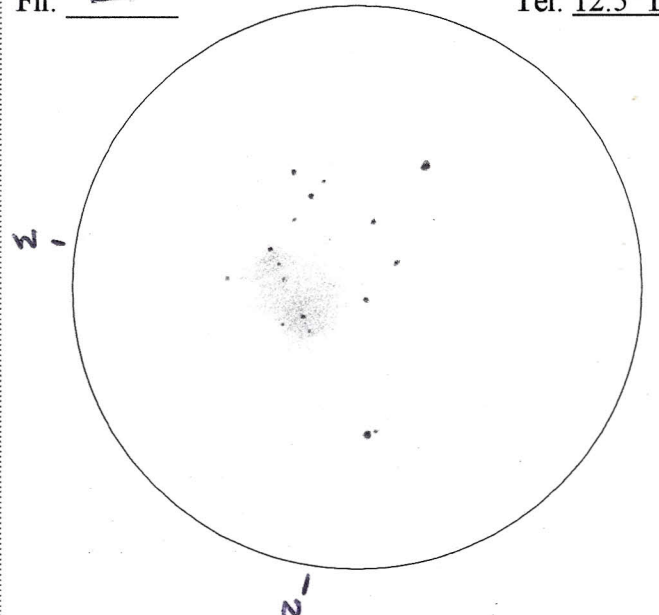
Small cluster. More concentrated in
