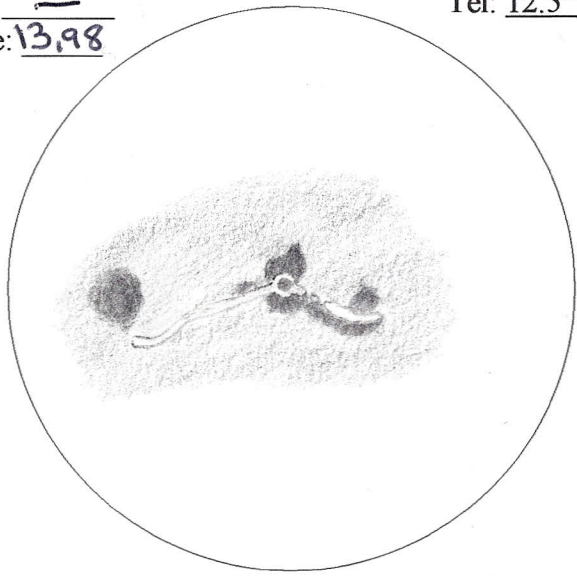
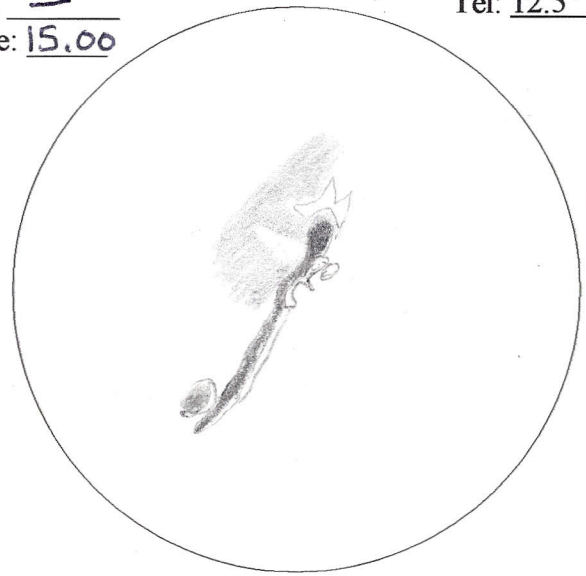

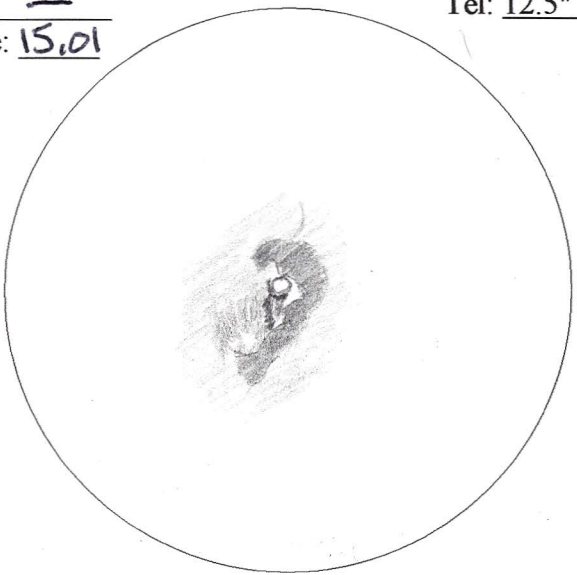
A light rille running ESE/WNW with a small crater near its center point. Sun angle is very high so not much shadows visible.

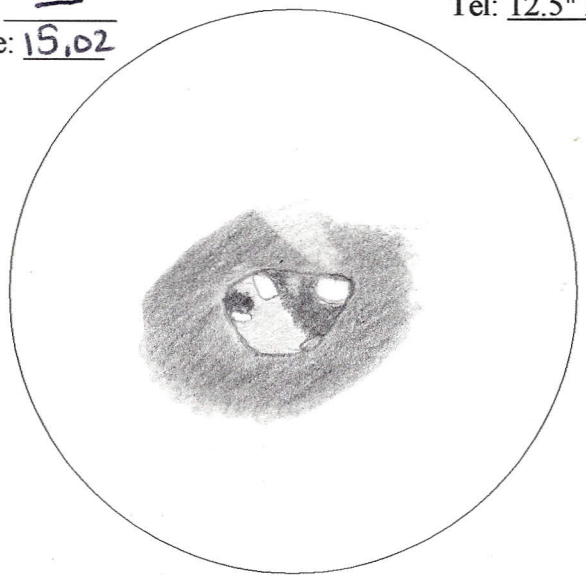
A fairly straight dark streak (valley) through mountainous terrain. Lighter mountains all around.
